AUGUSTO D ODEROSI

Augusto Poderosi was born in Rome he works eclectically in the fields of figurative and audiovisual arts he started his activity in the laboratories of scenography to the Cinecitta Studios. Sculptor, painter and restorer to the holy see he realizes numerous artistic patronage for the Basilica Papale di S.Paolo Fuori le Mura, di S.Antonio di Padova, Basilica Del Cristo Re (Rome) for the Vatican City and various other Roman churches. Refines the knowledge on sacred themes graduating from the Pontificio Ateneo Benedettino of Liturgical Institute of Sant'Anselmo. From 2000 to 2003 he was the artistic director of the laboratory of art to the Basilica di S.Paolo Fuori le Mura carrying out tasks of master of sacred and liturgical art to the Benedictine monks of the monastery he worked on the restoration of the portal of the Basilica for the Jubilee 2000. In 2008 is the first artist has receive permission to expose sculptural installation "Corpo di Luce", at the Basilica of S Pietro in Vincoli at Rome under the eyes of the Statue of Moses by Michelangelo, exposure sponsored by the Institute of IMAIE. Collaborator of famous advertising agencies of the caliber of Movie Magic he is also choreographer in combat film and actor for spot directed by Tony Scott and Rob Cohen he has also collaborated, with directors like Mario Missiroli and Ugo Gregoretti for the theater Argentina and the theater Valle. The great passion for cinematography leads him to collaboration as the actor with some of the major Italian directors debuting with Federico Fellini, in Ginger & Fred, Damiano Damiani, Carlo Lizzani, Mauro Bolognini, Lamberto Bava, Giancarlo Nanni, Sergio Martino, Pal Sandor, Stefania Sandrelli; For tv Claudio Calicari, Paolo Poeti, Gianni Lepre, Paolo Fondato, Giulio Questi, Giuliana Gamba, Renato Di Maria, Marco Serafini, Paolo Bonora, Angela Redini, Carlo Alberto Pinelli, Paolo Monico Sebastian Leda e Francisco D'amorim Lima. In 2016 is the winner for the financing for High Formation of Film Acting delivered by Audiovisual Institute to achieve the first Cinematografic Martial Combat as Artistic Director and fight Arranger. The format was held at the www.cinecitta3.tv and was broadcast throughout the world. Lecturer at the University of Cinematography in the field of Cinematographic Martial Combat.




Noor Taan

TERESA BONTA

Teresa Letizia Bontà was born in Licata Agrigento in 1981. She approached the world ofself-taught photography at a very young age. The first subject that stimulated her wascertainly her environment and the artistic and landscape beauty of her country. Among herfavorite themes there is no lack of people, the woman, the surrounding reality. Hers is asimple but careful to detail photography. Her photos tell what she is and what she hasbeen. He realized his first photographic exhibition in 2017 in Licata, gaining a lot of successand being mentioned in many newspapers. In Venice in the same year she participated in thecompetition Premio Arte Laguna, then in Mestre at the Atelier association he realized hissecond photographic exhibition. In the summer of 2018 she realized a photo shoot in Sicilyin Palma di Montechiaro, where she dared to go further, breaking through the wall of taboos: She immortalized the kiss between two women in front of the church. This shot caused quitea stir from the population and newspapers. The shots had the positive consent of thewell-known stylist Stefano Gabbana who on Instagram appreciated its art. In September 2018 he applied again for the Lagoon Art Prize with more intimate themes and with soughtafter shots. In May 2019 he ranked second in the "Michelangelo Vizzini" award on womenand Sicily, also obtaining the Special Jury Prize for the shot that immortalizes the twowomen kissing. Remaining strong with the theme Sicily, participates in the InternationalFestival of the Mediterranean in Mazzara del Vallo, presents ten shots that tell his land andthe work done in recent years. Other awards arrive in March 2020 from the D'E.M. Art Gallery of Venice, which awards herart with the critics' prize. Also in 2020 Teresa begins to show in her shots the continuous artistic evolution, whilemaintaining her roots, begins to experiment new horizons, bringing in her photos current and committed themes. She plays with colors, with contrasts with the lines of bodies tellingemotions and everyday life. The international magazine Lens Magazine has awarded Teresaas one of the ten big names in black and white.
