


## Specific Areas of Concern Map 1: Thursday 23 and Friday 24 November 2019





## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2: Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 November.






#### Assessment of flood risk



The overall river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Ongoing minor impacts are possible in parts of Yorkshire today as a result of previous rainfall.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible across parts of south-west England and south-west Wales today (Thursday) and tomorrow. This is due to spells of rain and showers falling onto wet catchments.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible more widely across England and Wales on Saturday and into Sunday and across the south of England on Monday due to rainfall over saturated catchments. Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected more widely across England and Wales on Monday.



## Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of south-west England and south-west Wales today (Thursday) and tomorrow. This is due to spells of rain and showers falling onto wet ground.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible more widely across England and Wales on Saturday and into Sunday and across the south of England on Monday due to rainfall over saturated catchments. Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible but not expected more widely across England and Wales on Monday.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible in North Lincolnshire during the next five days.



### Coastal/Tidal


The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

High tides and unsettled conditions combine early next week however any coastal flooding impacts are currently expected to be minimal.

### Flood risk matrix



#### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### **MINIMAL**

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
