

Specific Areas of Concern Map 1: Thursday 29 and Friday 30 October 2020








Specific Areas of Concern Map 2: Saturday 31 October 2020

Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW on Thursday and Friday.

Significant river flooding impacts are possible in Wales, the Midlands and northern England on Thursday and Friday due to heavy and persistent rainfall. Minor impacts are also possible more widely across western parts of England and Wales.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible on Saturday across parts of Wales and northern England with a further period of heavy rainfall.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Thursday and Friday.

Significant surface water impacts are possible in Wales, the Midlands and northern England on Thursday and Friday due to heavy and persistent rainfall. Minor impacts are also possible more widely across western parts of England and Wales.

Minor surface water impacts are possible on Saturday across parts of Wales and northern England with a further period of heavy rainfall.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.


Flood Guidance Statement

10:30hrs Tuesday 27 October 2020



6-10 day forecast

Unsettled weather continues on Sunday and early next week with the potential for further heavy and prolonged rainfall falling on to areas already saturated and sensitive to further rainfall.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
