





### Specific Areas of Concern Map 1: Saturday 19 December 2020.















## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2: Sunday 20 and Monday 21 December 2020.





### Specific Areas of Concern Map 3: Monday 21 and Tuesday 22 December 2020.





#### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW today (Saturday) and tomorrow (Sunday).

Minor river flooding impacts are probable today and tomorrow and are possible on Monday and Tuesday in western parts of the Midlands and the Welsh borders, as larger rivers continue to respond to recent rain. Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are also probable in parts of south Wales and the south-west and north-west of England today.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in the south of Wales and the south of England on Sunday, Monday and again on Wednesday due to further spells of heavy rain falling on already sensitive catchments.



### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in the south of Wales and the south of England on Sunday, Monday and again on Wednesday due to further spells of heavy rain.



## Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.




## Groundwater

### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### **MINIMAL**

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
