




Minor surface water flooding is possible on Monday across parts of the east of England. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised, minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of eastern England this (Monday) afternoon due to heavy showers.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised, minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of the east of England this (Monday) afternoon due to heavy showers, with small urban rivers and watercourses most prone. Elsewhere, and at all other times, river flooding is not expected.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
