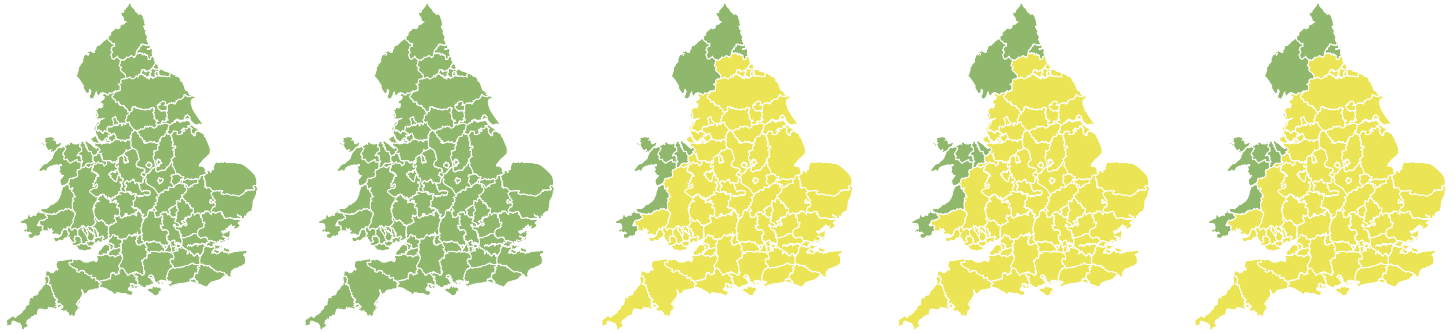

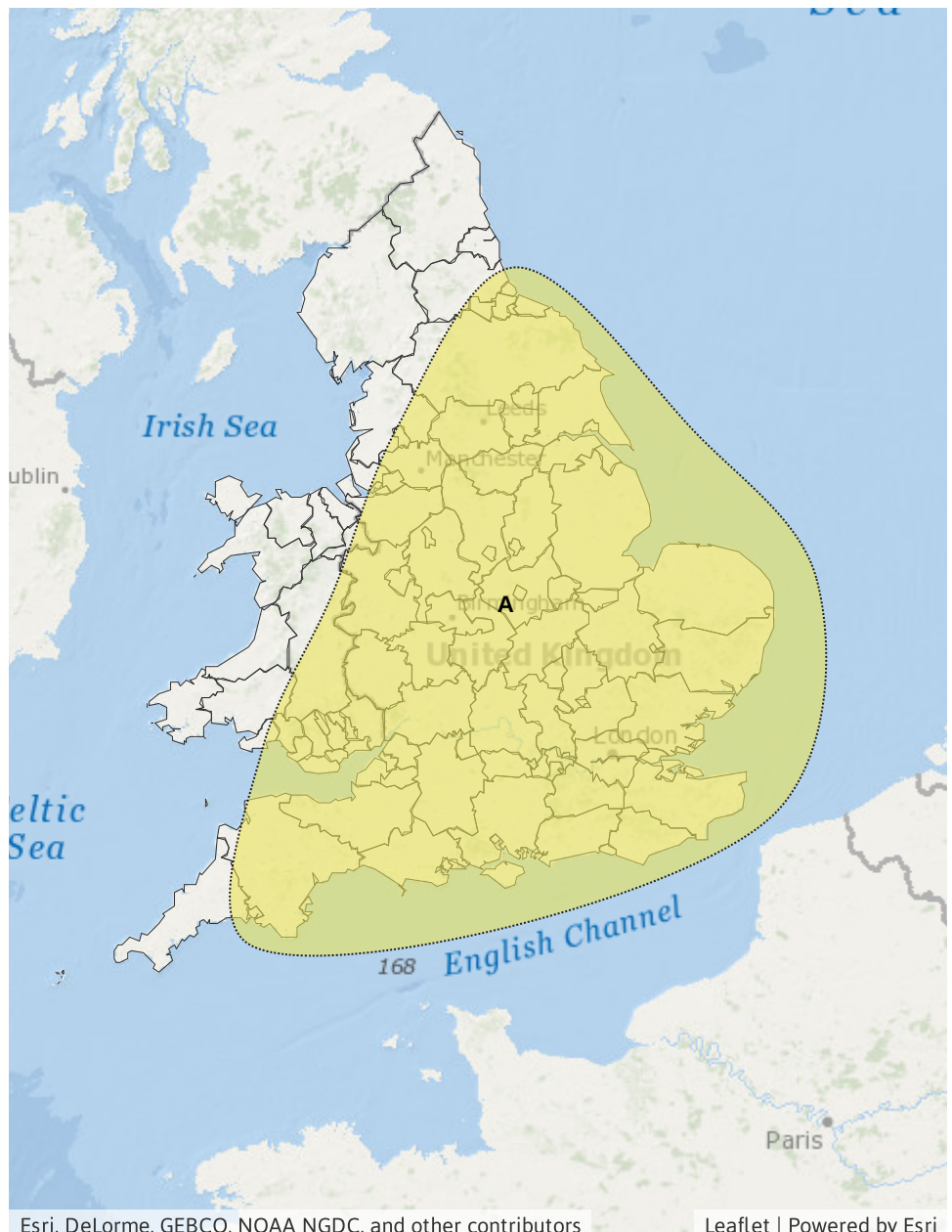
Significant surface water and river (urban and rapid responding) flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales from Wednesday to Friday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW for the next five days.

Localised significant surface water flooding impacts are possible in parts of England and Wales from later Wednesday to Friday. This is due to scattered and possibly heavy, thundery downpours which may develop from the south later in the day on Wednesday and into Thursday and Friday.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW for the next five days.

Some very localised significant river flooding impacts are possible in parts of England and Wales from later Wednesday to Friday. This is due to scattered and possibly heavy, thundery downpours which may develop later in the day on Wednesday and into Thursday and Friday. This may result in elevated water levels in some small, rapid responding and urban watercourses.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
