



Localised, minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of England and Wales today (Thursday). The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised, minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of the north of England, parts of central, southwest and south-east England and Wales today (Thursday). Refer to Specific Areas of Concern Map. Localised, minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected elsewhere across England and Wales today and Friday. This is due to widespread, heavy and thundery showers becoming persistent at times.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

High spring tides during the weekend and into next week, however no more than minimal coastal flood impacts are currently expected.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
