What are the symptoms of LGV?

- There may be no symptoms;
- LGV can cause a small painless sore on the head of the penis or inside the bottom then;
- Painful discharge, rectal pain, constipation, bloody poos or bleeding from the rectum.

LGV

How can you prevent LGV transmission?

- Change condom for each sexual partner;
- Use fresh gloves every time you fist a different partner;
- Wash your penis before changing sexual partners if condoms have not been used;
- Do not share lube, sex toys or anal douches;
- Wash sex toys and anal douches with soap and water to clean the equipment.
