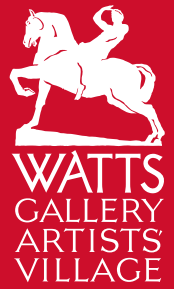


FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



How can I make a booking?

To book call 01483 813589 or email groups@wattsgallery.org.uk. We recommend booking a minimum of 1 month in advance.

What are the admission charges for groups?

Groups of 8 people or more receive discounted entry at £9 per person (£4.50 for students). Guests also receive a 10% discount in the shop.

Is there a minimum group size?

In order to receive discounted entry, groups must include at least 8 people. We are happy to accommodate large groups of up to 48 people.

What is your cancellation policy?

If you cancel with less than a week's notice, payment of your bill remains fully payable.

Is the Artists' Village accessible?

Most of the site is wheelchair accessible and there is accessible parking on site. Guide dogs are permitted throughout the site.

Are guided tours available?

We offer a range of guided tours, talks and workshops for groups.

Foreign language tours are available in French, Italian, German and Spanish. Audio-visual tours are available for blind and partially sighted visitors.

Is there coach parking on site?

Coaches can drop groups off at the Visitor Centre and park nearby at Loseley Park. Coach drivers get free admission.

Will refreshments and/or lunch be provided?

A variety of refreshment and food options are available from our award-winning Tea Shop, starting from £3 per person. Catering must be arranged in advance.

What methods of payment are available?

Payment can be made by cheque, cash or credit card. All admission and catering fees must be made as one payment two weeks in advance of your visit. Cheques should be made payable to Watts Gallery Trust.

Is there an additional discount for National Art Pass holders?

Group members who are also National Art Pass holders receive half price off general admission (£4.75).
