

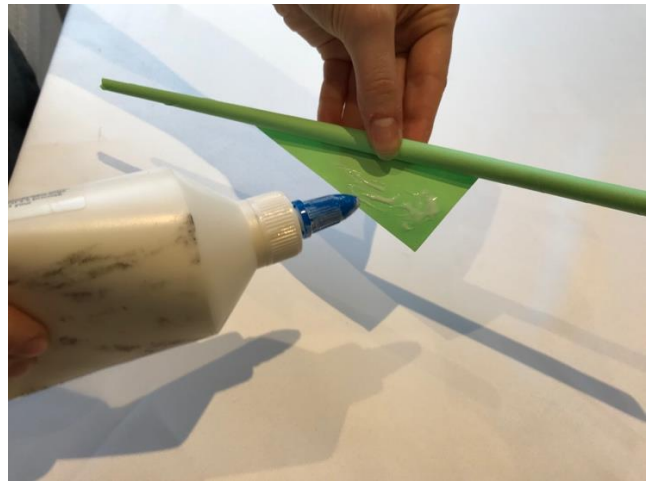
# The Make Space: Secret Garden Flower Paper Craft



## Materials

- Glue
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Coloured paper, including green for the stems

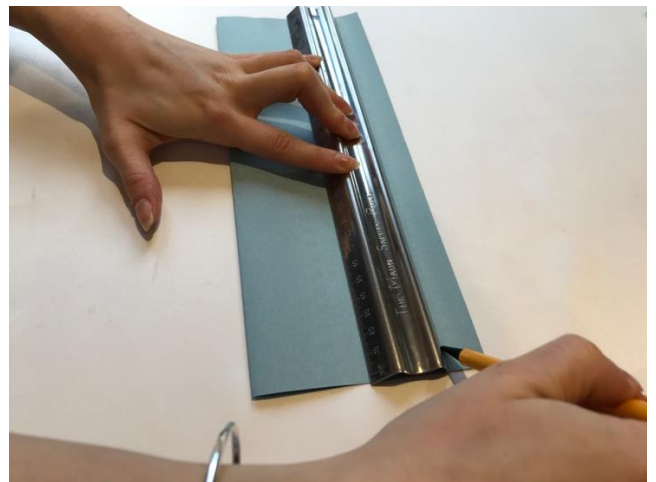
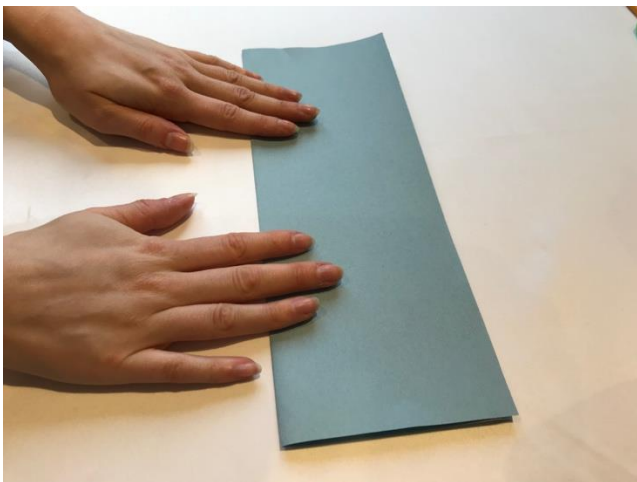
## Step 1



### Making the stem

Roll the paper up, starting from the corner, rolling diagonally. Once you've rolled it up tightly to form your stem, glue the last part of the paper to keep the stem rolled up without coming apart.

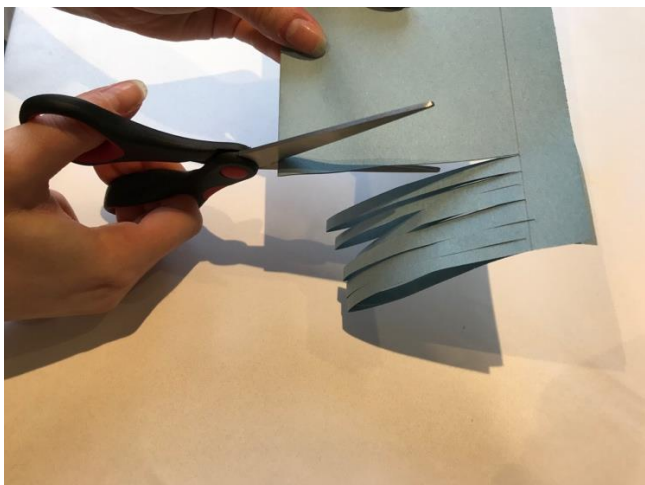
## Step 2



### Making the flower

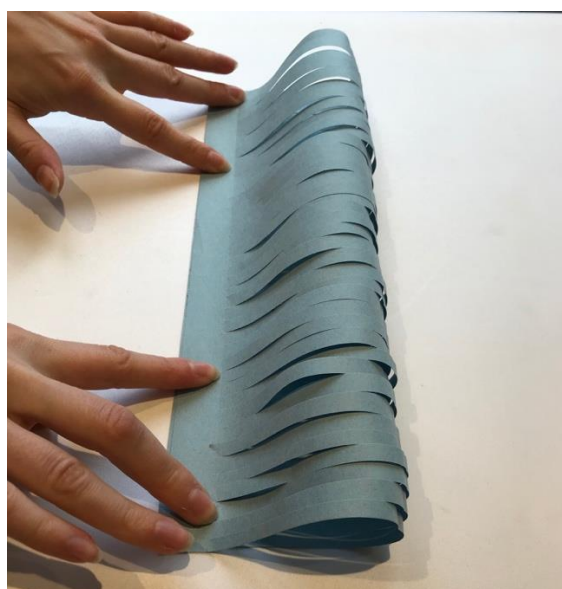
Fold the coloured paper in half (long ways), then draw a line on the open edge roughly 1.5cm away from the edge.

### Step 3



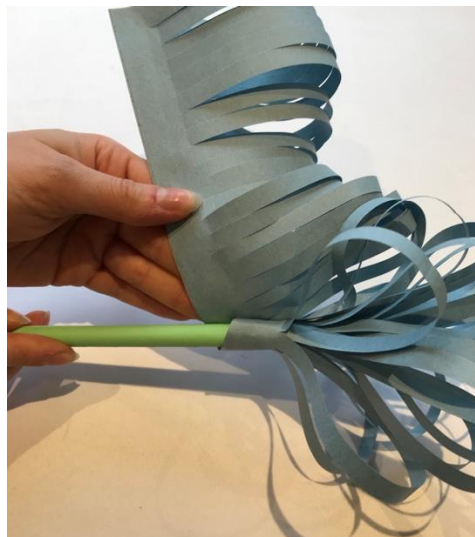
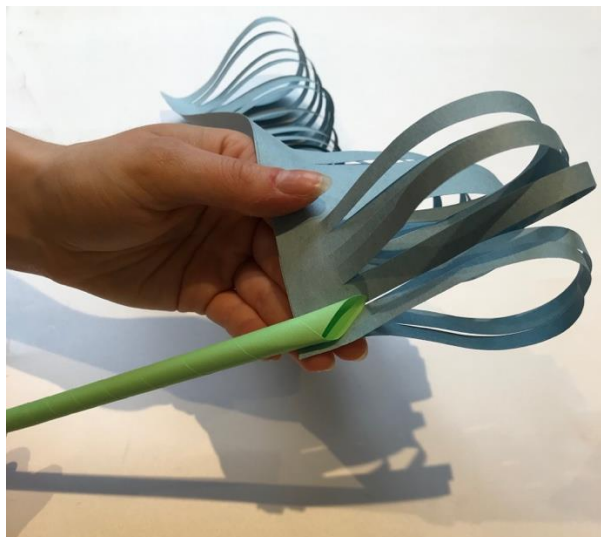
Cut strips up to the line (roughly half a centimetre thick). These are cut on the folded edge. Do this all the way along the paper.

### Step 4



Open out the paper and fold it back but the opposite way. Glue down the long edges and leave to dry.

## Step 5



Glue one end of the flower to the top of the stem.  
Start to twist the petals around the stem, working your way down the stem, glue the end to the stem.

## Step 6



Repeat steps 3 and 4 using another piece of card (this can be in a different colour for effect)  
Again, twist it around the stem, starting from the end of the previous colour.  
Glue the end to secure the petals.

You have your lovely flower!

Make more in different colours and put in a vase.... Enjoy!
