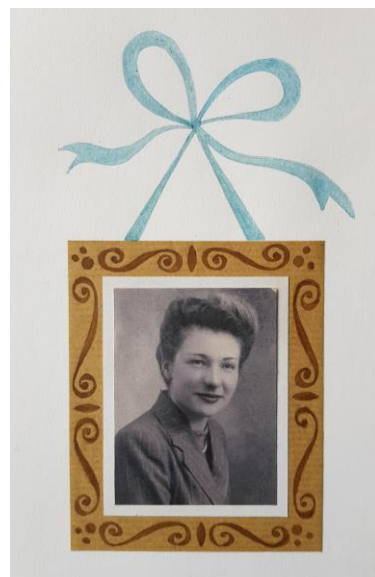


The Make Space

Photo collage and illustration

Inspired by Mary Watts's photo album, artist Kate Chittenden shares two ideas for combining photographs with drawing to create whimsical collages.



Doorway

Put someone in a doorway and draw another wonderful and imaginative place around them! Where will your door be? On a space ship or beach hut? On a tree trunk or a cottage or a magic shop?



Materials

- A photo of yourself, a friend, a pet, a celebrity or even a place
- Paper
- Glue
- Pencil
- Pen
- Scissors
- Your IMAGINATION!



Cut your photo into a doorway shape. Stick it near the bottom of the white sheet of paper. Use a pencil to draw a doorway around it, and then sketch the outlines of the place where your door is.

Go over the pencil lines with a pen and add all the fun details of your imaginative place.

Photo Frame

Draw and decorate a double mounted 'frame' around your chosen photograph and 'hang' it on a ribbon.



Materials

- A photo
- White paper - at least A4
- Small piece of white and brown paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Paints and paintbrush, or felt pens or coloured pencils



Stick the photo onto white paper and trim out leaving a thin border (about 5mm). Then stick this onto brown paper, and trim out leaving a wider border (about 12 mm). Stick this onto the big sheet of white paper, leaving plenty of room above for the bow.



Decorate the brown frame, then draw a ribbon and bow above it, and colour it in.
