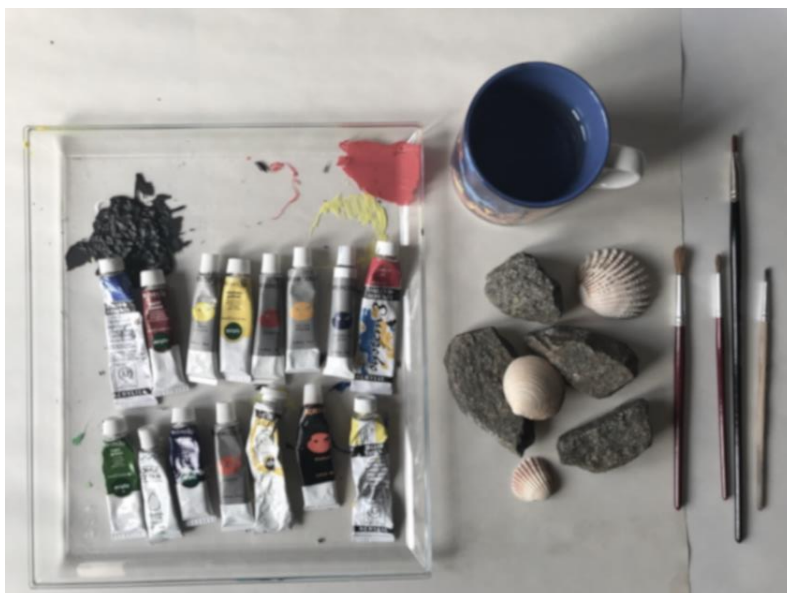


The Make Space

Painted stones and shells



Materials

- Stones and/or shells
- Paint
- Paint tray or old plate
- Paint brushes
- Cup of water

Step 1



Wash off any dirt from your found stones or shells.

Step 2



Paint a background colour all over your stones or shells. Then leave them to completely dry.

Step 3



If you have household paint, or enough paint to put in a small tub, you can easily add colour by dipping the stones or shells in the paint halfway. Then leave them to dry once more.

Step 4



Finally, you can now use other paints to add fun patterns. Use spots, stripes or any decoration you like.

Step 5



Once your stones have completely dried, you can now put them up on a shelf. Enjoy painting!
