Puffy Paint Ice Creams

G F Watts experimented with mixing different things into his paint - like potato juice! Now you can experiment by making foamy paint to make summery colourful ice creams.

Materials

- PVA Glue
- Shaving Foam
- Food colouring
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Paint Brush

Step 1: Cut out an ice cream shape from cardboard

Step 2: Mix 1 parts PVA glue with 2 parts shaving foam and add a few drops of food colouring

Step 3: Paint puffy paint thickly onto the top of the ice cream using a brush spoon or piping bag

Step 4: Add sprinkles - glitter, little pieces of coloured paper, pompoms

Step 5: Paint or collage cone using ready mix paints or tissue paper

Step 6: Leave to dry
