We will be using the 'webinar' function for our festival so only those assigned 'panellist' status (the speakers in the session) will be able to turn on cameras and microphones.

You will be able to communicate using the Q&A button and the chat function – this will be set up so that you are only able to communicate with Autistica staff and we ask you to keep it free for any technology questions or problems.

We ask all delegates to be respectful of the time and energy of everyone and be aware that we have audience members and speakers with a wide range of experiences and backgrounds. You may not agree with everything you hear and that's ok, we encourage open discussion and questions on our Zoom webinars and on social media accounts (#AutisticaFestival)

If we find anyone to be targeting individuals in a way that can be read as harassment or bullying or acting in a way that stops others from being able to participate in a session, then we will remove you from the session and from future events.

### Speakers:

Please make sure that your name on Zoom is clear and correct (especially if you share zoom accounts). Feel free to include pronouns after your name if you wish to have them stated.

We will ask all speakers to keep themselves muted and with their cameras off when not speaking – this helps to reduce background noise, and helps the audience follow the content of the session.
