# PhD Program Doctor of Philosophy (60 credits)

#### MINOR REQUIREMENTS

Selected in consultation with a Research Advisor

Minor 1: A minimum of 12 credit hours of thematically related graduate courses selected from the areas of Science (including Computer Science), Mathematics, and Engineering

Minor 2: A minimum of 9 credit hours of thematically related courses, in any area

#### **RESEARCH REQUIREMENTS**

A minimum of 30 credits registered as SYS 699. Dissertation Research

#### **EXAM REQUIREMENTS**

**Qualifying Exam**: Taken no later than 18 credits beyond the MS Program

**Area Examination:** Taken after the Qualifying Exam and no later than 42 credit hours after matriculation into the PhD program

**Defense**: A public defense of the final PhD dissertation research is required. The defense can be scheduled any time after the end of the term in which the Area Examination was completed.

#### PREFERRED PROGRAM APPLICANTS

The preferred program applicant will have an MS in Systems Engineering. Applicants who have earned an engineering master's degree, but not in systems engineering, and who have demonstrated systems engineering work experience, are also strongly encouraged to apply. All applicants will be considered for admission into the PhD program based on a thorough review of their application materials.

Students who have not yet earned an MS degree will not be considered for the WPI Systems Engineering PhD program until completion of the MS program.
