

Discover You Why and Get Leverage for Change

In order for any of us to do something and to really succeed at it, there has to be a big enough reason *why*. There needs to be a compelling reason as to why *you* are now taking a particular course of action and be honest with yourself about it. Especially if it is going to require a significant portion of your time and energy in order to accomplish it.

And now it's time to get clear on what your motivations are for embarking on this journey in the first place.

Now it's time to up the ante a little. Answer the four questions below. I've given you some examples at the end to help you understand what I mean. There is space for five responses, but feel free to write as much as you can. To assist you with answering the questions above and to get you thinking before you start this exercise here are some examples that people I've helped sometimes give.

Example Answers

Question 1: What will happen if I don't learn to increase my energy levels?

- ➤ I will continue to feel sluggish and un-productive day after day
- I will miss out on opportunities because I don't have the energy

Question 2: What will happen if I do learn to increase my energy levels?

I will find time to study for that course / write that book

I will be able to give my best to my kids

Question 3: What won't happen if I do learn to increase my energy levels?

- ➤ I won't succumb to feeding myself those high calorie treats at 11am/3pm
- I won't feel like I'm 10 years older than I actually am

Question 4: What won't happen if I don't learn to increase my energy levels?

- I won't get that promotion as I won't be able to cope with the increased workload
- I won't be able to do as much with my weekends as I'll be continually recovering from the week

In order for you to change, you <u>MUST</u> have that compelling reason (or reasons) and that's why this process is so important. Think about how many times you've maybe set yourself a goal or wanted to achieve something but gave up shortly after starting out. The reason invariably is that you didn't want it badly enough. You didn't have a compelling reason why you must change. That what the exercises in this handout are all about, so be sure to complete before watching video 3.
