Bin 8. Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rosé Brut NV
A delectable rose Champagne made using only Pinot Noir fruit from Grand Cru villages. This champagne has delicious raspberry and redcurrant fruit flavours with a subtle brioche finish. £95

Bin 150. Chateau Chasse-Spleen 2000
There's red and black fruit, a slight smokiness, the slightest hint of Paprika as well as some tar. The finish shows a beautiful length with good presence £140

Bin 151. Chambolle-Musigny 2011
Bright, intense colour and complex aromas evoking violet, black cherry and damp earth. According to the vintages, there are also notes of truffle and game. Refined tannins coat the palate. Good balance between texture and acidity. Long aftertaste, with notes of cherry and candied fruit £150

Bin 152. Chateau Prieure Lichine 2007, Margaux
Bright red, very young colour. Pleasant, ripe, almost jammy nose. Dense, silky mouthfeel with lots of well-balanced mellowness. A Château in the midst of a rebirth which is a constant source of amazement. £180

Bin 153. Chateau Du Tertre 2004, Margaux
An exotic, nearly flamboyant wine that seduces the taster with its forward display of earthy, herb-tinged cassis and black cherry fruit, round, soft, lush palate, and concentrated, fleshy finish. £185

Bin 154. Chateau Giscours 2002, Margaux
Château Giscours is a blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Merlot picked between October 1 and 15. There remains that almost Pomerol-like personality on the nose, quite perfumed and floral with sage and burnt toast scents tincturing the dark berry fruit. With continued aeration, there is a just a hint of rooibos. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, quite ferrous in the mouth and lightly spiced. £195

Bin 160. Pol Roger Brut Réserve NV

It is full, rich yet fresh, and loved by those who prefer a richer Champagne style. Pol Roger is beautifully balanced with great depth of flavour. It exudes class and is perfect for really special occasions.

Bin 161. Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut Rosé NV

An incredibly pretty pale rose colour. This is a delicate, fresh and delicious rosé which is made by adding Cumieres Rouge to the traditional blend, with the re-fermentation taking place after blending.

Bin 162. Louis Roederer Cristal 2006

This is the exquisite Champagne of the Russian Tsars, which is dense and soft with a sophisticated touch of acidity. A true harmony of flavours. Absolute perfection.

Bin 163. Picpoul de Pinet 2016 Domaine La Serre

Picpoul de Pinet is a wine from Languedoc where the locals drink it with shellfish and seafood. The name translates as "lip Stinger", which refers to the grapes natural acidity. It is this acidity that makes it such a refreshing wine with citrus bursts and tropical fruit notes. On the palate it is zingy with white stone fruit, lemon peel and intense minerality .

Bin 164. Chenin Blanc, Franschoek Cellar, Stellenbosch, South Africa

This Chenin Blanc has pineapple and melon on the nose, a clean, zesty entry on the palate with peach and butterscotch. Easy and enjoyable.

Bin 165. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 2015

A vibrant mix of kaffir lime, lemon zest and nectarine aromatics intermingle with the bright perfume of orange blossom. The palate is brimming with ripe citrus and stone fruit flavours that are framed by sleek and succulent acid architecture.

Bin 167. Festivo Malbec, Argentina 2016

Owned and operated by Chateau le Gay of Pomerol. This full bodied wine is produced from 100% Malbec displaying delicious spices of plums and hints of dark chocolate. £30

Bin 168. Château De La Tilery, Alma Soror 2011

The most prestigious wine of the domaine produced from selected vines giving exceptional length and character. A nose of cooked black fruits with black truffles, mushrooms and dark chocolate on the palate. A wine to be experienced. £45

Bin 169. Petit Fleur, Linda Flor, Argentina 2010

The Petite Fleur from Mendoza comes with a French pedigree of real note in that it is owned and run by Chateau Le Gay in Pomerol and shares the highly respected winemaker Michael Rolland. This smooth and silky wine has dark and jammy fruit with lots of spice with notes of cedar and tobacco. It has a great structure and a long sumptuous length. £48

Bin 170. Château du Donjon Cuvée Prestige

Donjon's Flagship bottling. Powerful primary aromas of ripe black fruit and hints of strawberry/raspberry. Very dense on the palate, with black fruit and red cherry flavors. Firm, structured and exceptionally rich. £49

Bin 171. Bois Pertuis, Reserve 2005

Intense purple colour with violet highlights. Powerfull and fine aromas with spicy notes of vanilla, liquorice, cedar and hints of roasted coffee. On the palate it is a very elegant, harmonius wine. £68

Bin 172. LUIGI BOSCA 'Gala 1' Malbec/Petit Verdot/Tannat 2015

Concentrated, modern, full-bodied and highly persistent wine with ripe tannins, displays notes of toffee and toasted coffee beans as a result of its ageing in oak. Harmonious and complex wine with a long fin £58

Bin 174. Remoissenet Pere & Fils Beaune Greves Premier Cru, Cote de Beaune 2002

Aromas of moist earth, forest underbrush and crushed stone. High notes of perfume...campfire smoke and spring flowers. Vibrant acid backbone intertwined with red berries, spice and minerals. Gorgeous balance and good concentration for a Pinot Noir.

Bin 175. Gevrey-Chambertin, Albert Bichot 2009

A fantastic "Gevrey" with a ruby red colour and some raspberry coloured nuances. Aromas of ripe red and black fruit on the nose with notes of oak and spice. Silky, well structured tannins and well balanced on the palate with a fruity round finish.

Bin 176. Château Sociando Mallet 2005

The wines of Sociando Mallet are characterized by a very deep and dark color, complex aromas of little red fruits and a well-integrated fine oaky touch. They are by tradition long-keeping wines. The wines are full-bodied, straight and elegant, with a lot of freshness and depth.

Bin 178. Château Brane Cantenac Margaux Grand Cru Classe 2005

Deep colour with a fragrant lift of ripe Cabernet Sauvignon. Shows strength of flavour without heaviness, leafy, with a very Margaux-long lingering finish. A great wine from a great vintage.

Bin 179. Albert Bichot : Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er cru Château Gris 2009

Appealing at first glance, these wines feature beautiful, deep, brilliant red colour. The nose is just as flattering, with aromas of ripe red and black fruit enhanced by spicy notes that develop as the wine opens up.

Right from the start, these wines' complexity is perceptible on the palate through their body and fullness. Then, their balanced structure is revealed, supported by round, silky tannins. On the finish, these rich wines boast fabulous length and leave a sensation of fullness in the mouth.

FRENCH WHITE WINE

- Bin 40. Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine Mandard 2015** BTL
This 100% unoaked Sauvignon gives fresh gooseberry fruit and a crisp finish with a snappy citrus zing. £22
- Bin 41. Chateau Cassemichere, Muscadet**
Chateau Cassemichere is well known for its dry and mouth-watering freshness. Light in body it finishes with crisp acidity. £23
- Bin 42. Chablis, Vieilles Vignes, ACC, Burgundy 2015**
This great wine displays a pale yellow colour; the elegant nose expresses fruity aromas of grapefruit, lemon and pears through to tropical notes of banana. It has a long and balanced finish. £35
- Bin 43. Chateau de la Tuilerie, Grenache Roussane 2015**
This wine has delicate mineral notes, citrus fruits and white flowers on the nose with a fresh finish on the palate. £35
- Bin 44. Chateau Simon, Blanc Graves AC 2016/7**
A classic summer Sauvignon Blanc from Graves. Yellow with green hues, nice citrus notes appear on the nose as well as white flowers. Very appealing on the palate with lovely balance. £35
- Bin 45. Gewürztraminer Reserve, Domaine Jean Geiler 2014**
This is an incredible wine from Alsace, made using hand-picked grapes which are harvested early to retain good levels of acidity. It is sweet, spicy and stylish with a great concentration. £38
- Bin 46. Sancerre, Jean-Paul Balland Blanc 2014/2015**
A sauvignon blanc with great weight and substance. It has plenty of vibrant green fruit and herbal flavours, but it has a weight and texture that stands it above the rest; with a truly rounded finish. £42

FRENCH WHITE WINE

- Bin 47. Pouilly-Fuisse, Les Vieilles Vignes, Jacques Saumaize 2014/2015**
An intense wine made from 60 year old vines, with superb aromatic complexity in which fresh hazelnuts, roasted almonds, honey and white flowers with a long finish. £54
- Bin 48. Pouilly Fume, Château de Nozet, Domaine de Ladoucette 2015**
Made from 100% old vine Sauvignon Blanc; this is fresh and crisp with gentle stony minerality and lemon giving the wine a beautiful structure balanced by a fruity roundness, with a finish marked by hints of citrus fruits. £56
- Bin 49. Chateauneuf Du Pape, Domaine Grand Veneur 2014**
A fantastic white Chateauneuf du Pape with delicate characteristics of dried apricot, honey and elderberry. This wine is gloriously rich and full-bodied, balanced by a bright and cleansing minerality. £66
- Bin 50. Saint Aubin 1^{er} Cru Gamay, Jean Claude Boisset 2013/2014**
This Saint Aubin 1er cru is fresh and attractive, with character of lemon, lime and hints of peach. There is fine density and a lovely mouth feel to the round yet vibrant middle weight flavors and a very fine minerality adding a touch of lift leading to a nicely balanced finale £68
- Bin 51. Sancerre Grand Cuvee, Domaine Balland 2012**
This is one of Sancerre's greatest whites. The fruit is beautifully integrated, with ripe grapefruit blending harmoniously with the slightly spicy flavours of the oak. Truly one of the finest Sancerre's we have ever tasted. £70
- Bin 52. Chassagne Montrachet, Remoissenet Pere & Fils**
Toasty, mineral, creamed apple and lemon drop nose, with hints of coconut milk, vanilla and spearmint. Dry, firm, fresh, and spiced palate. Long, very complex and evolving finish £85

EUROPEAN WHITE WINE

Bin 60. Rioja Blanco Barrel Fermented, Bodegas Muga, Spain BTL
This is a delectable white Rioja that has complex toasted aromas with fresh vibrant fruits that give way to zesty lime, spicy and vanilla-toasted oak flavours. £28

Bin 61. Albariño, Martin Codax, Rias Baixas, Spain 2015
From Galicia in North-West Spain this is a light, fresh and youthful wine with delicate flavours of apricots and peaches. It has a zesty and well-defined backbone with subtle hints of stone fruits and nectar. £29

Bin 62. Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Italy 2015/2016
A fantastic expression of the Cortese grape. A wine that is gold in colour and has a light, fresh mineral and citrus bouquet. The palate is crisp and dry, with a hint of ripe pears and a complex array of red and green apples £29

Bin 63. Riesling Trocken, Rheinhessen, Austria 2015
This is proper Riesling. Made using biodynamically grown grapes, this is fresh, citrusy and dry. A great aperitif with crab or prawns. £31

NEW WORLD WHITE WINE

Bin 70. Cape Mentelle Semillon / Sauvignon, Margaret River
Soft and bright with abundant fruit including lime and white melon perfectly complemented by the heady lemon blossom aromas of Semillon. £35

Bin 71. Petit Clos, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand
This French-owned vineyard in Marlborough has produced a wine with a complex character, which offers a hint of smoky grass and plenty of ripe fruit ranging from fig and melon to notes of passion fruit. A delicious wine which is full-bodied but with a silky mouthfeel and a touch of gingery spice on the finish. £45

Bin 72. Cloudy Bay Chardonnay, New Zealand 2014
A great option for lovers of Chardonnay, this comes from the famous Cloudy Bay and is a wine that is well balanced between a creamy texture and crisp acidity, offering fresh fruit flavours of lime, grapefruit, peach and melon, finishing with dried floral accents and a mineral edge. £52

Bin 80. Fleurie, Georges Duboeuf

Classic Fleurie with fresh cherry fruits and a fragrant, floral perfume. Concentrated fruit and light tannic presence are testament to the cru status of this wine. An attractive wine with a silky texture.

Bin 82. Jean-Marc Lafont de Bel Air Brouilly 2013/2014

An explosive nose of red fruits and hints of vanilla characterise, this beautifully enticing, deep ruby-purple coloured wine. Redcurrants and strawberries are in abundance on the palate and the finish is punctuated with a hint of ginger.

Bin 83. Seguret, Domaine De L'Amauve, Cote Du Rhone Villages

A beautiful dark coloured wine from the village of Seguret. The nose is intense, with tones of spice and black fruits. It is round and has a good body, with accompanying tannins and impressive length. The finish is rich with notes of black cherry, sweet spice and sweet tannins.

Bin 84. Crozes-Hermitage "Petite Ruche", M. Chapoutier

One of the world's most versatile grape varieties and from one of the world's greatest winemakers, this Syrah displays a myriad of dark and red fruit, tanned leather and smoky scents that will accompany well with roasted meats, turkey and game birds.

Bin 85. Chateau de Mercey, Mercurey Premier Cru 2013

This Mercurey has a beautiful deep ruby red colour. The nose is intensely fruity with redcurrant, plum and black cherry with hints of white pepper. This is a wine of good structure and character with a persistent finish that is perfectly matched to red meat dishes and classic cheeses.

Bin 86. Château Condât, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru 2012

A gold medal winning wine from Saint Emilion with superb structure and solid, tight tannins. This wine has a great quality of silkiness and length of finish and has been grown on the same soil structure as that of the most famed Chateau Cheval Blanc.

FRENCH RED WINE

Bin 87. Blason D'Issan, Margaux 2010

The second wine of the incredible Chateau d'Issan. It's made in a similar way to the first wine, but grapes are sourced from vines that are about 20 years old. Elegant and pure with soft tannins and balanced acidity. A classic Margaux style showing great purity of fruit.

Bin 88. Châteauneuf Du Pape, Domaine Grand Veneur 2009/2013

An outstanding and elegant Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this is loaded with spice, garrigue, violets, and underlying minerality that's backed up by perfectly ripe black cherry. Silky and polished on the palate, with a full, concentrated mid-palate, and ripe tannin that shows on the finish, this is a solid wine that will delight any Châteauneuf lover.

Bin 89. Château de Fonbel, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, 2010

This is a delicious St Emilion with a wonderful array of flavours that are layered and fresh with violets, cedar, and cassis and an attractive floral background that is reminiscent of wines from the Margaux appellation. This is a fantastic, well balanced wine.

Bin 90. Echo de Lynch Bages, Pauillac 2010

A sensational effort for the vintage, this textured, opulent, superb Lynch Bages. Medium to full-bodied with an opaque dense purple colour, notes of flowers and cassis, a layered texture that builds incrementally in the mouth and tremendous purity and depth.

Bin 91 . Château L'Évêché, Pomerol, Bordeaux, Francois Janoueix,

A small vineyard from this most sought after commune of Bordeaux. Rich and round with a gorgeous succulent texture with delicious plummy fruit. A great wine from a great vintage.

Bin 92. Château Du Tertre, Margaux 2010

Renowned to be the best Du Tertre so far. Fresh and spicy with tobacco, earth and herbs on top of sweet, fresh cherries with a mouthfeel of pure velvet. Incredible.

EUROPEAN RED WINE

- Bin 100. Montepuciano D'Abbruzzo, Folonari, 2014** BTL
Crafted from selected grapes in the region, this wine is full and vigorous; eloquent and clean tannins, with a long, intense finish. £22
- Bin 101. Rioja Vina Marro Crianza 2012**
This wine has expressive mature fruit on the nose with mineral notes and spice. On the palate it has ripe, mature tannins that make for a smooth but lengthy finish. £23
- Bin 102. Chianti Classico, Conti Seristori 2014/2015**
This wine is bright ruby red in colour with garnet tints and has a strong bouquet with a delightful fragrance of spiced cloves, cinnamon and dried flowers with hints of marinated raspberries. The flavour is dry with a distinctive, lingering aftertaste of liquorice and toasted almonds. £24
- Bin 103. Esporao Reserva Tinto, Alentejo 2013**
One of Portugal's best reds, this is a blend of Portuguese varieties and Cabernet Sauvignon aged in oak. Ripe spice and red-berried fruit is underpinned with vanilla. On the palate this wine is medium bodied, with a delightful dry finish. £38
- Bin 104. Rioja, Seleccion Especial Reserva, Bodegas Muga. 2010**
A Rioja with great depth and substance. Deep dark red colour, slightly floral with a dusty nose, ripe black fruit with a hint of spice giving in to a silky finish. £59
- Bin 105. Brunello di Montalcino, Barbi, 2008/2010**
Wine with a deep ruby to brick-red colour and a richly complex, dry, full and soft palate. A muscular, full-bodied wine with great richness. £94
- Bin 106. Baglio Gibellina 2016 (Vegan) - Italy**
This full bodied red wine is a blend of fresh Frapatto and dried Nero d'Avola grapes grown at high altitude in the Sicilian hills. The rich concentrated red berry fruit is balanced by a lovely freshness and a smooth finish. £27
- Bin 107. Amarone Black Label Pasqua**
An elegant, full-bodied deep ruby red wine, with clean and vibrant fragrances of currants, blackberries and sweet almonds on the nose, with notes of vanilla. Warm and rich, with polished, silky tannins and a long finish. £59

NEW WORLD RED WINE

Bin 110. Wakefield Promised Land Shiraz/Cabernet, South Australia 2010

Wakefield make their wines in a soft fruit-driven style. Here the Shiraz is the dominant partner showing typical rich spice, chocolate and fruit character with a soft smooth finish.

Bin 111. Devil's Corner Pinot Noir, Tasmania 2014/2015

Bright crimson with purple tinges with a strongly perfumed nose that combines blackberries with hints of violets and a touch of ginger spice. The finish combines fine tannins and firm acidity making it a very easy drinking yet refined Pinot Noir.

Bin 112. Bernard Series Bush Vine Pinotage, Belingham SA 2014

A full-bodied wine with a deep plum, purple colour. Intense damson and black cherry fruit, with hints of smoked meat and truffle notes, and a spicy toastiness from the oak.

Bin 113. Cape Mentelle Cabernet / Merlot, Margaret River, W.Australia

On the fuller side of medium-bodied, this wine tastes of dark cherries and blackcurrants. Peppery and almost a bit minty, it has elegantly smooth tannins and a super long length.
