

UPDATE TO THE LEVEL 4 MDCL ASSESSMENT

AAT conducted a review of this assessment towards the end of 2017 as there were general concerns about pass rates. As a result of the review, the following changes were made to the MDCL assessment in March 2018:

- The number of tasks were reduced from 10 to 8
- The number of marks available were reduced from 160 to 120
- No change was made to the duration of the assessment, which remains at 2.5 hours

On reviewing the new sample assessments and the updated learning outcomes, the following items have been removed from the syllabus:

- The calculation of fixed overhead efficiency and capacity variances
- Shadow prices

No other changes have been made to the syllabus content. Therefore you can be assured that all materials in the current 2017 Course Book and Question Bank remain valid (with the exception of the two areas mentioned above), and it may well be that the real assessment may test syllabus areas in a more straightforward manner than our materials suggest.
