SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. A scholarship made pursuant and subject to these terms and conditions (“Terms and Conditions”) is made by BPP University Limited (company number 02609100) (“BPP”).
2. These Terms and Conditions and the general terms and conditions from time to time of the eligible BPP Programme apply to the scholarship (“BPP General Terms”). The BPP General Terms are available at <http://www.bpp.com/terms>.
3. Please read these Terms and Conditions and the BPP General Terms carefully and print off a copy for your records.
4. By accepting a scholarship you are confirming your agreement to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and by the BPP General Terms.
5. If there is conflict between these Terms and Conditions and the BPP General Terms, these Terms and Conditions will prevail.
6. In these terms, “**BPP**” means BPP University Limited (company number 02609100), *BPP House, Aldine Place, 142 -144 Uxbridge Road, London W12 8AA*.
7. In these terms, “**IADS**” means International Association of Dental Students, *c/o FDI World Dental Federation. Tour de Cointrin. Avenue Louis Casai. 84 C.P 3 1216 Cointrin, Genève, Switzerland*.

Conditions for entry

8. To be eligible for the prize the entrant must:
 - a. be a member of IADS;
 - b. email IADS General Secretary at secretary@iads-web.org stating the reasons why they believe they should be awarded the scholarship, including:
 - i. the entrant’s involvement in student associations in their country;
 - ii. the entrant’s experience as a student leader;
 - iii. whether the entrant has attended any of IADS’ previous projects; and
 - iv. details of why the entrant may benefit from receiving the scholarship discount;
 - c. have been selected and referred to BPP by the IADS Executive Committee;
 - d. be able to demonstrate that they meet BPP’s entry criteria, both academic and otherwise, for the relevant Programme; and
 - e. be aged 18 years or over.

9. Winners must have accepted a place on the Dental Summer School by midnight (GMT) on 31st May 2017 (“**Closing Date**”). Winners accepting their place after this date will not be considered for a scholarship.
10. Entrants who are studying at BPP at the time of this application will be eligible to apply for a scholarship for a Programme that they have not yet undertaken. Any scholarship awarded will not be applicable to their current programme of study.

The prize

11. Winners will receive a 50% discount (£2,500) on the full price (£5,000) of the Dental Summer School.
12. Prizes do not include travel, accommodation, food, living costs, relocation costs, any other financial support of any kind, additional study materials and any amounts payable to any professional body in order to participate in the relevant courses or any costs associated with exemptions and examination entries.
13. No compensation or cash alternative will be offered. Prize details are correct at the date of publication. BPP reserves the right to substitute any of the prizes for a prize of similar value should the original prize become unavailable for any reasons.

Conditions relating to the award of the prize

14. Only 10 scholarships are available.
15. The Dental Summer School must be commenced at BPP Birmingham Dental Institute in the United Kingdom on its relevant 2017 start date. No deferral of the scholarship will be permitted and the scholarship may be offered to a runner-up if the winner is unable or unwilling to commence the Dental Summer School on the relevant start date.
16. The decision of BPP is final and no correspondence will be entered into concerning the award of a scholarship.
17. Winners will usually be notified that they have won a scholarship by email, telephone or post within 21 days of the relevant closing date.
18. Provision of a scholarship is subject to the relevant winner signing a scholarship acceptance form in the form prescribed by BPP.
19. Entrants who require a student visa to study with BPP are responsible for obtaining their own visa and meeting any necessary visa requirements and for ensuring that their attendance is satisfactory to meet those visa requirements. BPP will not admit any person to a Programme unless that person has the legal right to study the relevant Programme in the

United Kingdom. Where a winner is unable to demonstrate such right, the relevant scholarship may be offered to a runner-up and BPP will have no liability to the original winner in relation to the scholarship.

20. Winners must be available to attend reasonable publicity and events as requested and may be filmed, photographed or otherwise recorded by BPP or other third parties for publicity and the winners consent to the use and publication of their personal data for such purposes. If any winner is unable to attend such publicity and event, the relevant scholarship may be offered to the runner-up of their scholarship.
21. In the event that a scholarship passes to a runner-up in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, that runner-up shall be bound by these Terms and Conditions as though that runner-up were the winner.
22. Employees, and their immediate families, of BPP are not eligible for any of the scholarships.
23. Winners cannot use this scholarship in conjunction with any other discount or offers by BPP for the course.
24. By entering the competition for a scholarship, you agree to be bound by the decisions of BPP in relation to the award of the scholarships.
25. Except in the case of death or personal injury caused by its negligence or that of its personnel (for which liability shall be unlimited), BPP shall not be liable to any winner or entrant (and/or any guest of any winner or entrant) for any loss or damage howsoever caused (whether in contract, tort or otherwise) arising out of or in connection with this scholarship.
26. BPP has the right to withdraw the offer of any scholarship and select an alternative winner if:
 - a. a winner is ineligible to enter this competition for any reason;
 - b. a winner requires a student visa to study with BPP and is unable to obtain such a visa or meet any necessary visa requirements;
 - c. the winner does not complete and submit a valid application within the relevant time for submission of applications;
 - d. BPP does not receive confirmation of the winner's address within 14 days of any request;
 - e. a winner does not accept or breaches any of the BPP General Terms;
 - f. BPP does not receive from the winner all documentation required in connection with the scholarship within any deadline notified by BPP; and/or
 - g. a winner is unavailable on any specific date or dates notified at the time of entry.
27. Entrants acknowledge that the fulfilment of any scholarship may be subject to execution by the applicant of further documentation in respect of any scholarship.

28. The winner must complete all formalities with BPP.
29. BPP is not liable for any delay or failure to perform any obligation to the winner or other applicant that is caused by any circumstances beyond its reasonable control or by any act or omission of any third party.
30. These Terms and Conditions and any non-contractual obligation arising out of or in connection with them shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law and BPP and the winner and any applicant irrevocably submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts with regard to any claim arising out of or in connection with these Terms and Conditions and any non-contractual obligation arising out of or in connection with them.
31. BPP reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship at any time without notice. BPP may update or amend the scholarship, these Terms of Award and/or the General Terms and Conditions to comply with law or meet its changing business requirements without notice to you.
