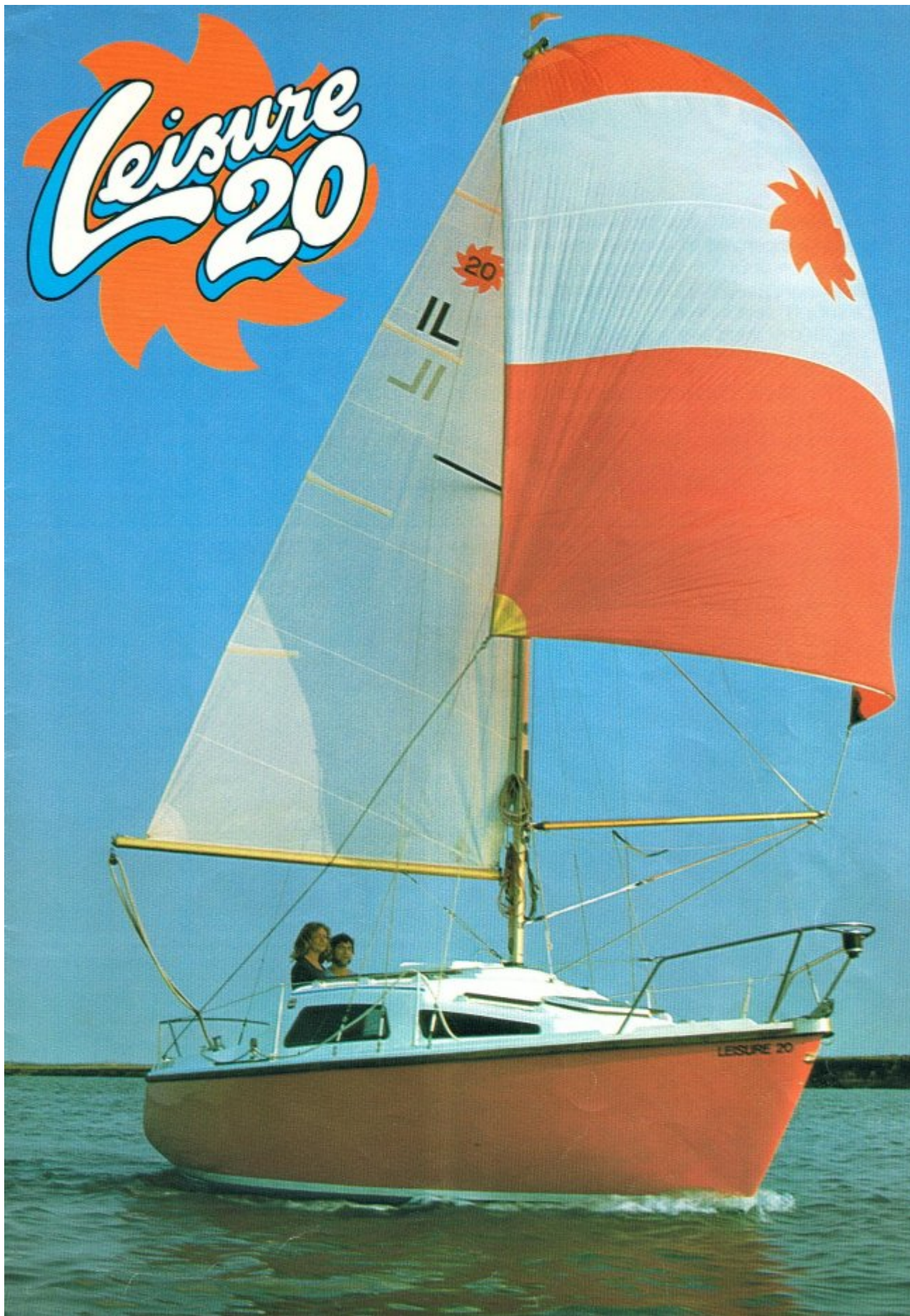

Cobramold Ltd., is a Stansted, Essex, based Company who have gained a wide experience of GRP moulding over the past fourteen years. Since the introduction of the 'Leisure 17' seven years ago they have built over 2000 of them and over 450 of the more recently introduced 'Leisure 23'.

The latest addition to the Leisure range of family sailing cruisers is the Leisure 20, designed for Cobramold by Horst E. Glaser, a West German designer. The design is such that it gives well balanced accommodation and superb sailing ability.

Available in three versions, fin keel, twin keel and centreboard to meet the requirements of individual tastes and needs. It is constructed in glass re-inforced plastic, with Lloyds approved material and S.B.N.F. approved, to provide a relatively maintenance free boat.

The standard specification is very comprehensive and includes stainless steel pulpit, stemhead, main marine genoa track, R.W.O. mainsheet track, Barlow winches, Marlow terylene running rigging, stainless steel standing rigging, stainless steel bottle screws, gold anodised mast

complete with Barton roller reefing and 6oz. terylene sails.

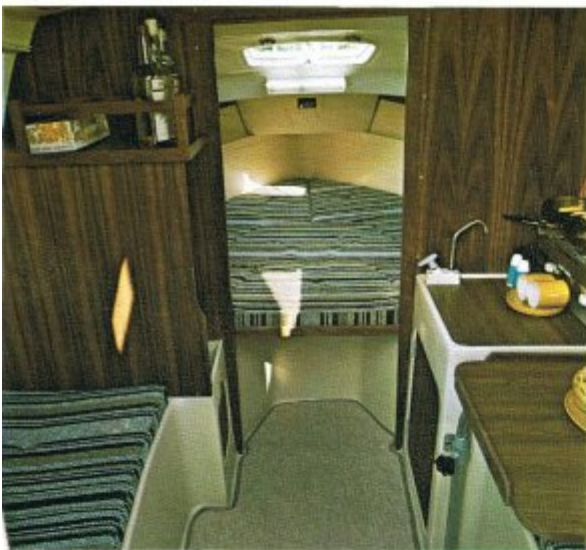
All wooden trim is in maintenance free teak which is attractive to the eye as well as the time conscious owner.

Below decks the one piece moulding giving 5'4" (162m) headroom incorporates two quarter berths with stowage under, gimballed alcohol stove and sink complete with water pump and draining board. The galley area is ventilated and there is a hanging locker on the port side.

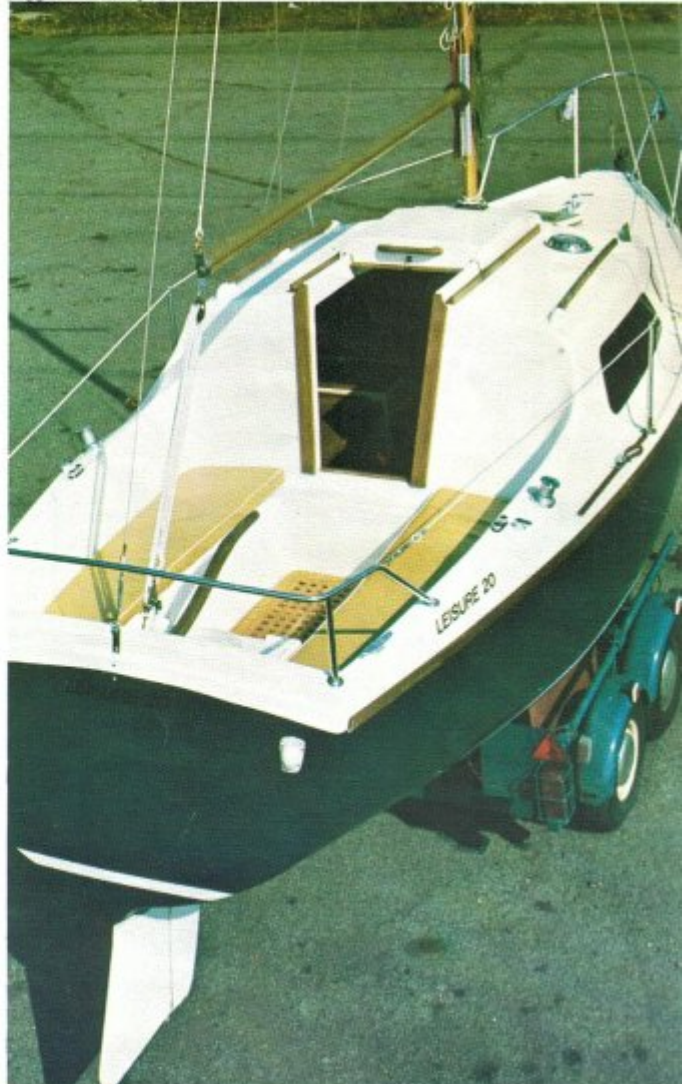
A spacious forecabin provides a good double berth with toilet under, three stowage lockers, two shelves and a translucent fore hatch for access to foredeck and anchor locker complete with anchor chain and warp.

All berth cushions are 3" (77mm) thick foam filled, except the 2" (51mm) outside seat cushions which add more comfort to large self draining cockpit.

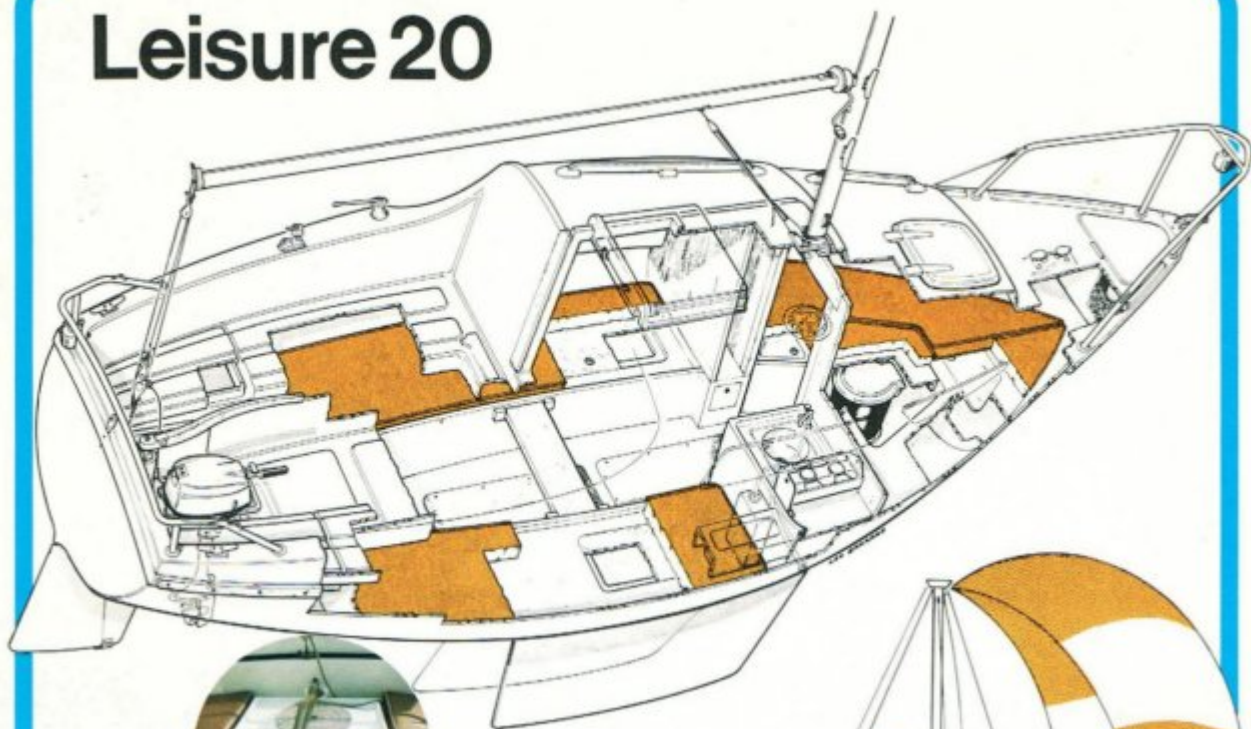
The outboard motor is mounted inboard through a tunnel in the centre of the cockpit with a locker on either side accessible from hatches in the cockpit.
