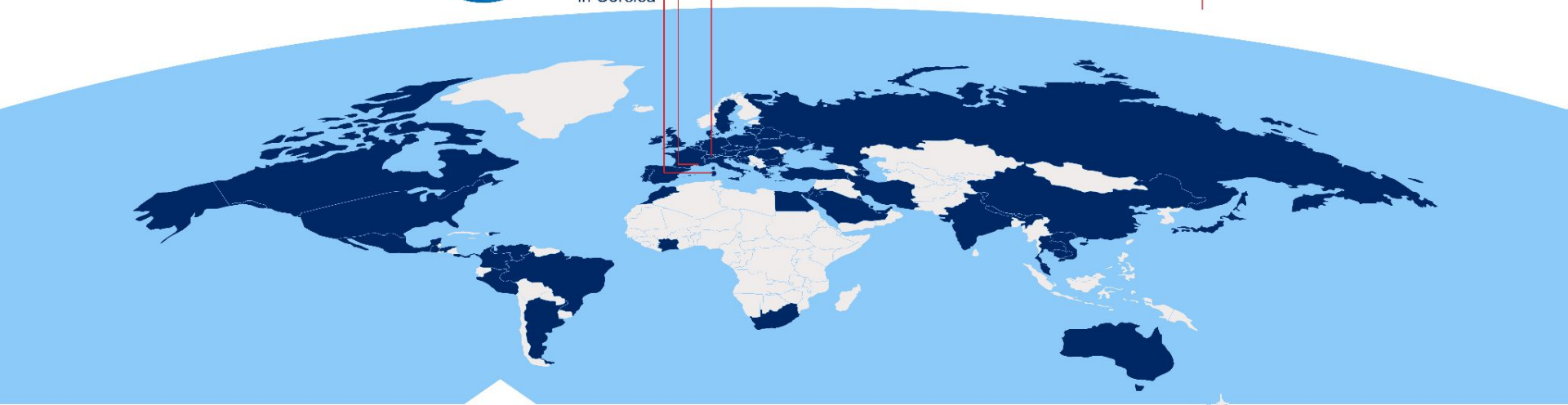

Our SILC Camps

All SILC Camps focus on developing practical leadership skills rooted in 21st-century learning. Students strengthen essential abilities such as goal setting, time management, collaboration, communication, decision-making, entrepreneurship, and creativity. Learning happens through doing - students actively apply these skills while taking part in a wide range of exciting, hands-on activities. The focus of the learning outcomes varies slightly from camp to camp, depending on each setting and theme.

Learning by doing

Each camp offers a full schedule from morning until evening, packed with adventure and discovery. Unlike traditional camps with classroom sessions in the morning and a single activity in the afternoon, SILC Camps provide continuous, experience-based learning through outdoor challenges, team projects and real-world adventures. All activities are suitable for every experience and fitness level, and most include our Challenge by Choice approach, allowing students to select their own level of challenge and comfort.

Culture: Care & Contribute

At SILC, we foster a culture where every student feels valued, supported and inspired. Our students look out for one another, embrace new experiences and celebrate diversity. Together, we create an international community where collaboration, kindness and shared success make every moment more meaningful — and far more fun.

Personal Action Plans, Certificates and Post-Camp Follow-Up

At the end of each camp, students complete a Personal Action Plan, identifying the skills they wish to continue developing and outlining how they will apply them back home. Every participant receives a certificate recognising their participation in our programmes. To extend the learning journey, we also offer an optional online follow-up session to review and support progress on each student's Personal Action Plan.

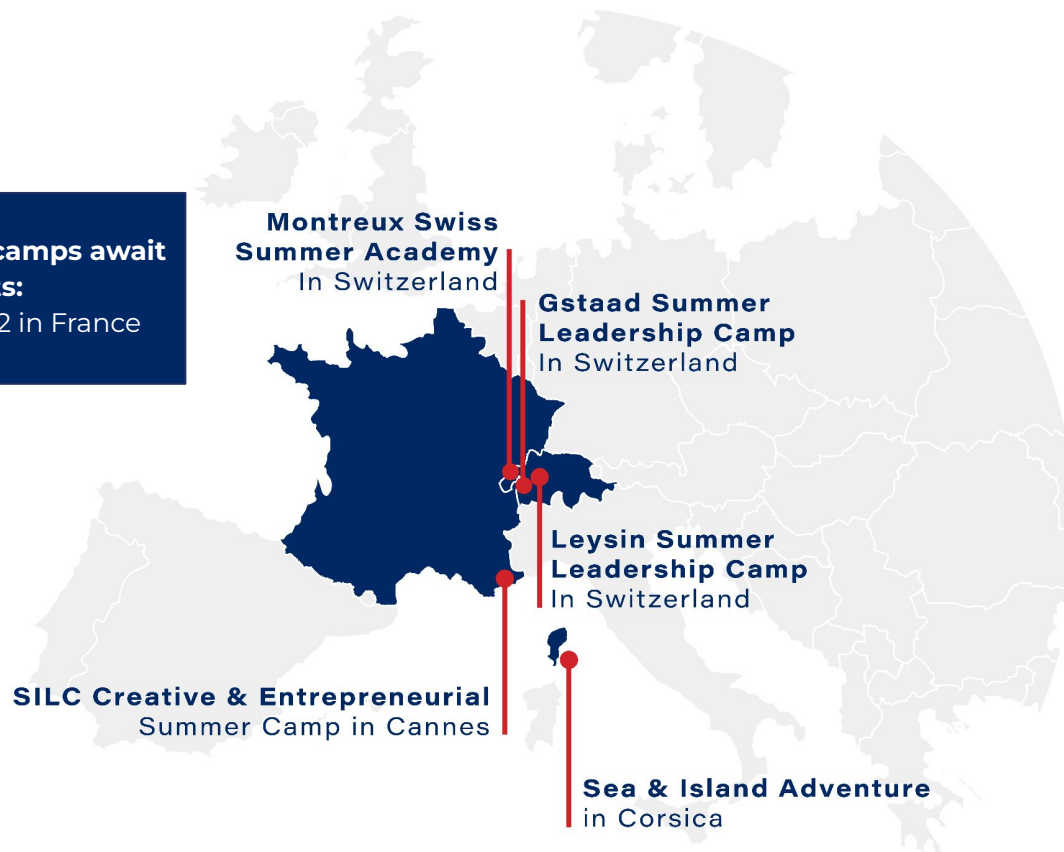

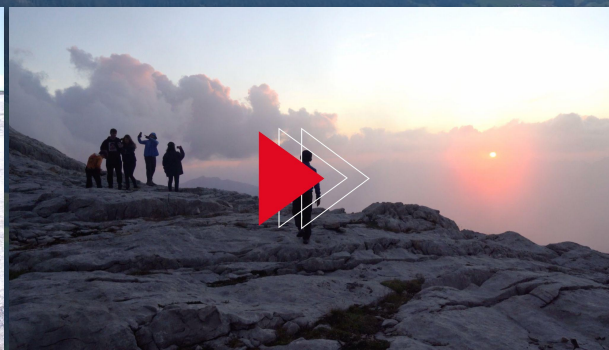

Hosted at our beautiful lakeside campus, Montreux Camp blends Swiss tradition with modern comfort. A beautiful Swiss boarding school, the campus offers cozy dorm-style rooms, spacious common areas, and sweeping views of Lake Geneva, creating a true home away from home.

Students are accommodated with the utmost attention to detail and comfort in our traditional and comfortable Swiss boarding house. Each room is shared between only one other student, with the possibility to share rooms with a friend or relative. - Cancellation between 15 May and 1 June 2026 – 80% refund of the total camp fee excluding the non-refundable deposit of CHF 1,000
- Cancellation from 1 June 2026 onwards – 50% refund of the total camp fee excluding the non-refundable deposit of CHF 1,000

No refund is made for cancellations as of 15th June 2026, inability to obtain an entry visa for Switzerland/France, a shortened stay, missed activities or workshops, withdrawal or dismissal during the camp, and in case of force majeure circumstances such as events/occurrences that are out of the control of SILC Academy such as, but not limited to, natural disasters, pandemics, airport strikes, accidents, technical difficulties, conflicts, fire, and bad weather conditions.
