3 Nights 4 Days

Day1

City Tour -During Yerevan city tour you will see all the major sights of the capital, including the Republic Square, the Opera house, the Cascade where you will see the statue of the world-famous sculptor Fernando Botero "The Black Cat". Matenadaran (depositary museum). We will also drive via Baghramyan Avenue, where you will see the Parliament, the Palace of President, and the National Academy of Sciences. Visit Tsitsernakaberd - Genocide memorial for the victims 1915 Genocide of Armenians. The excursion also includes a stop in the Victory Park, at Mother Armenia monument, from where you will behold a panoramic view of the city and Visit the History Museum of Armenia. The final stop will be at the Food Market with its variety of fresh and dried fruits.









Day2

Tsaghkadzor Sevan

After Breakfast at 11; 00 we will start our tour. First we will visit Tsaghkadzor "Valley of flowers". We will visit famous ropeway of Tsaghkadzor, next point will be Kecharis monastery. Then we will continue to Sevan Lake-"the pearl of Armenia". This fresh-water lake of volcanic origin is situated at an altitude of about 6,500 ft and is one of the biggest high altitude lakes in the world. Here we will visit Sevan Monastery.



Day 3

Garni Geghard

Today we will visit one of the main sights of pilgrimage in Armenia – the rock-hewn monastery of Geghard – a UNESCO World Heritage

Next point will be Vernissage open air marketSite. This is believed to be the place where the Holy Lance was kept in the middle ages.

The Holy Lance was brought to Armenia by apostle St. Thaddeus in the 1st century. Today hundreds of people visit this place and drink the crystal clear miraculous water coming from the spring inside one of the churches.
