

Tajikistan Tour Package

Day 1

Arrival to Dushanbe International Airport

Transfer and check in the Hotel.

Welcome breakfast in Hotel and free half day till 12:00

After lunch transfer to **Hissar Fortress**

30 km away from Dushanbe and only 4 km from Hissar village there is one of the main Tajikistan monuments - Hissar historical reserve.

Places to visit:

Hissar fort with ark built in XVI c and now reconstructed.

Registan - a square before fortress.

Old madrassah built in XVI c on the territory of 2250 sq m.

New madrassah.

Caravan Serai built in 1808.

Mosque "Sangin"

Mausoleum of Mahdumi Abzam built in XVI c over the grave of Khodja Muhhamad Haivoki.

History museum located in Old Madrassah building and has a display of 3200 exhibits.

Day 2

Transfer from hotel for Dushanbe City Tour

The monument of Ismoil Somoni is situated on Ozodi square. The height of the monument is more than 25 meters. This monument was placed in 1999 in honor of 1100 anniversary of the state of the Samanids. The monument is richly decorated with gold and looks impressively.

National library

The National Library of Tajikistan was officially opened in 2012. A nine-storey building with a total space of 45.000m² and containing approximately 10 million books is the largest library in Central Asia. The imposing white edifice is situated in the centre of the city and is yet another expression of the gigantomania of the Tajik government of the last years.

Rudaki Park

Abu Abdullah Jafar ibn Mohammad ibn Hakim ibn Abdurrahman ibn Adam Rudaki

Samarghandi - or just short: Rudaki. An ancient Persian poet and seen as the founder of Tajik culture. A statue is located in the Bagh-i Markazi park in central Dushanbe.

Rudaki

Abū 'Abd Allāh Ja'far ibn Muḥammad al-Rūdhakī (Persian: محمد بن جعفر عبد الله ابو و رودکی; died 941), better known as Rudaki (رودک), and also known as "Adam of Poets" (آدم)

(ال شاعر), was a Persian poet regarded as the first great literary genius of the Modern Persian language. Rudaki composed poems in the "New Persian" alphabet and is considered a founder of classical Persian literature. His poetry contains many of the oldest genres of Persian poetry including the quatrain, however, only a small percentage of his extensive poetry has survived.

At 13:00 we will continue our city tour

The flagpole consists of 12-metre sections of steel tube fitted together by crane. It was constructed and erected by Trident Support, based in [San Diego](#). The company was also responsible for [Azerbaijan's National Flagpole](#). It was shipped by D&F Logistics LLC - Dubai. The design phase for the flagpole began in July 2009. Fabrication of the pole's sections was completed in [Dubai](#) in October 2010. The sections were then shipped to Dushanbe, where construction of the flagpole began on November 24, 2010, Tajikistan's National Flag Day. The final assembly and erection took place during April and May 2011, with the first test flight of the [flag of Tajikistan](#) taking place on May 24, 2011. The flagpole cost \$3.5 million and was part of \$210 million worth of projects celebrating the 20th anniversary of [Tajikistan independence](#).

Initially building "Kohi Navruz" (Palace of Nowruz) was planned as a teahouse, but during the construction become into a palace. "Kohi Navruz" has - 12 unusual halls, each of which is made in a special style. The complex has an art room, a banquet hall, a lounge room with carved stone trim, plaster room decorated with mirrors, two VIP rooms. At the same time building is ready to place 3 thousand. 200 guests. All the rooms of the palace are decorated by local artists, craftsmen: there are wood carvings and Florentine mosaic from the local semi-precious stones, Mosaics made of colored mirrors, painted ceilings. On the walls - scenes from the ancient legends, on the ceiling - made in the old style, wooden ornaments, which are made mainly by craftsmen from Isfara. Around "Kohi Navruz" was planted a garden: there are redwood, fir, plum, chestnut, maple, evergreen and deciduous magnolia, buksusa, pine, cypress and birch. The height of the main building - 46 meters, and the area of "Kohi Navruz" with 12 rooms, surrounding pavilions, fountains and the trestle beds – is about three hectares.
