

TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

REGISTRATION FOR THE SFO - AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES SCHEME 2021/2022

DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION: APRIL 1st

Enrolment in the SFO takes place at the school you normally currently attend and also applies to those who may or will change schools in the autumn. Registration will continue to be valid at the new school. SFO is offered to pupils in the 1st to 4th years. The Municipality of Elverum also offers SFO places for children with special needs in the 6th and 7th years.

Registration takes place through the schools' administrative system, Visma: [Visma Flyt Skole](#) through the ID gateway. You will find a short guide to application here: [veiledning](#) (Norwegian only)

After logging in, select school in the left menu. Select "Sfo" for the child you are applying for, and then "Nytt opphold". Parents will receive a confirmation by e-mail / SMS that the application has been received and a notification that the application has been processed.

You do not have to apply every year, cancellations and venue changes are described in Chapter 5 of the regulations. To cancel the SFO place, you must log in to [Visma Flyt Skole](#) using the ID gateway.

Those of you who already have a SFO place do not need to re-apply. Those of you who no longer require a place must send a cancellation.

The regulations are published on Visma and on Municipality of Elverum's Internet pages.

Registrations received after 1st April, will be accommodated by the Principal to the extent that there are sufficient places and staffing in SFO.
SFO opening hours 07.00 - 17.00 outside school hours.
Some schools open at 06:45.

Full time costs NOK 3 250 and part time NOK. 2 580, -
Part time is up to 15 hours per. week.
During the holidays, part time is 35 hours and full time 50 hours per week.

Apply for reduced fees payable by parents

Low-income families can apply for a reduced price for a place in the after-school activities scheme (SFO). When you apply, you must document the household's total gross income.
