


# Installing 61" / 72" Workbenches



Unpack your workbench and check to make sure that it was not damaged during transit and that all items are included.

**WARNING!** The workbench is heavy. We recommend that 2 people unpack and assemble the workbench.

## **ASSEMBLY**

#### Left and Right Legs (see figures 1 & 2)

Attach the left and right legs to the workbench top and lower shelf:

- 1. Align the holes at the top of the legs with the holes located at the mounting bracket.
- 2. Insert a bolt with a washer through each of the holes of the leg and then through the mounting bracket holes.
- 3. Place a washer and nut onto each of the bolts and hand tighten.

**Note:** The nuts (H) are only required when assembling the open legs.

Repeat the steps for the remaining leg.
 Note: Do not fully tighten the nuts at this time.

#### Crossbar (see figures 1 & 2)

- 1. Attach crossbar to back of left and right legs.
- 2. Align crossbar end holes with the holes in the back of left and right legs.
- 3. Tighten bolts and washers through crossbar end holes into leg holes.

**Note:** Do not fully tighten the nuts at this time.

#### Lower Shelf (see figures 1 & 2)


- 1. Align the holes in the lower shelf with the holes in the legs.
- 2. Insert a bolt through a washer then through each of the holes in the legs and through the holes in the lower shelf.

  Note: Do not fully tighten the nuts at this time.
- 3. Set the workbench upright onto its feet. Make sure it is completely stable and resting on the legs, then fully tighten all nuts with a wrench.

#### **Drawer (see figure 2)**

- 1. Install the drawer by sliding it into place on the drawer runners.
- 2. Once drawer is in place on the drawer runners, align the holes of the retaining plate with the holes on the rear wall of the drawer.
- 3. Using the two self-tapping screws, fasten the drawer retaining plate to the rear of the drawer.




