- **DO NOT** overload the drawers or cabinets.




CAUTION!

- **ALWAYS** lock the cabinet doors and drawers when moving this product.


3. Identification and Unpacking

3.1 Product Overview

4. Assembly Instructions

Important: Before assembling this product, read and understand all the safety instructions listed in this manual. **DO NOT** fully tighten the bolts and screws until the workstation is fully assembled and level.

4.1 Attaching the Levelling Feet



- Attach the levelling feet (l) to the tall cabinet, base cabinet and worktop.

4.2 Attaching the Handles



- Attach the handles (H) to all the doors using ST6 X 12mm screws (1).

4.3 Assembling the Tall Cabinet



- Connect the upper body (B) and lower body (A) frames with ST6 X 12mm screws (1).

4.4 Fitting the Tall Cabinet shelves





- Fix the middle beam (E) with ST6 X 12mm screws.
- Then fit the middle shelf (F) and the other two shelves (G).

4.5 Cabinet Connection



- Connect the base cabinet (J) to the tall cabinet using M6 X 16mm bolts (2) and M6 nuts (3).
- Then attach the connecting plate (N) to the base cabinet with M6 X 16mm bolts (2) and M6 nuts (3).

4.6 Fitting the Worktop



- Connect the wooden top (K) to the leg unit (L) using M8 X 16mm bolts (4).
- Then attach to the connecting plate with M8X16mm bolts.

4.7 Fitting the Back Panels



- Connect the back panels (M) as follows;
 - **To wood** – use ST4.5 X 57mm screws (5) and D5 washers (6).
 - **To brick** - use ST4.5 X 57mm screws (5), D5 washers (6) and expansion pipes (7).

4.8 Connecting the Wall Cabinets



- Connect the wall cabinets (O) to the tall cabinet using M6 X 26mm bolts (2) and M6 nuts (3).

- Connect the wall cabinets (O) as follows;
 - **To wood** – use ST4.5 X 57mm screws (5) and D5 washers (6).
 - **To brick** - use ST4.5 X 57mm screws (5), D5 washers (6) and expansion pipes (7).

4.9 Fitting the Tall Cabinet Doors



- Fit the left doors (C) and the right doors (D) to the tall cabinet.

5. Maintenance

- Periodically clean the surfaces with a mild detergent and water.
- Remove any oil or grease with a non-flammable cleaning fluid.

5.1 Drawer Removal



- Pull the drawers out so almost fully extended.
- Press the levers on either side of the drawer side as shown to remove the drawers.
- Lubricate the drawer slides every 6months to keep a smooth operation.
