- Keep hands and feet away from the cutting line and trimming blade at all times.
- **ALWAYS** disconnect from the mains power supply
 - If the cord becomes damaged or entangled.
 - When leaving the machine unattended or not in use.
 - Before clearing a blockage.
 - Before checking, cleaning or carrying out any maintenance.

- After striking a foreign object to inspect the machine for damage.
- If the machine starts to vibrate abnormally, check immediately.
- **NEVER** operate the machine with defective guards or without the guard fitted, or if the cord is damaged or
- Keep the cord and extension lead away from the cutting part.
- Avoid using the machine in bad weather conditions especially when there is a risk of lightning.
- Only use replacement parts and accessories recommended by Draper Tools.
- Keep the ventilation openings clear of debris.
- The grass trimmer be should be serviced and repaired by an authorised repairer.

4.2 Connection to the Power Supply



CAUTION! Risk of electric shock. DO NOT open.

This appliance is supplied with an approved plug and cord for your safety.

If the power supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by Draper Tools, an authorised service agent or similarly qualified personnel in order to avoid a hazard.

The damaged or incomplete plug, when cut from the cord, shall be disabled to prevent connection to a live electrical outlet.

This appliance is a Class II[†] and is designed for connection to a power supply matching that detailed on the rating label and compatible with the plug fitted.

The value of the fuse fitted is marked on the pin face of the plug. Should the fuse need replacing, use a small plain-slot screwdriver to remove the fuse cover.

Ensure the substitute is of the correct rating, approved to BS 1362 and ASTA or BS Kite marked. This should only be performed by suitably qualified personnel.

†Double insulated : This product requires no earth connection as supplementary insulation is applied to the basic insulation to protect against electric shock in the event of failure of the basic insulation.



6.1 Assembling the Shaft Sections (Fig.1 – Fig.5)

• Assemble the handle and the top and bottom shaft sections using the screws (3.1) supplied as shown.







6.2 Attaching the Guard (Fig.6 - Fig.7)

• Attach the guard (4) using the screw (4.1) supplied.

7. Operating Instructions



Important: Before operating this product, read and understand all the safety instructions listed in this manual. Ensure that the product is fully assembled and correctly prepared for use.

7.1 ON/OFF Trigger Operation (Fig.8)

- Ensure the cutting spool is off the ground before starting the trimmer.
- Squeeze the trigger (1) to start the trimmer.
- · Release the trigger (1) to stop the trimmer.



7.2 Tap 'N' Go Cutting Spool Assembly (Fig.9 – Fig.10)

- · Check the cutting line regularly.
- When the cutting performance deteriorates, tap the spool button (6.1) on the grass. The cutting line will automatically extend, and any excess will be cut to length by the trimming blade (5).



Opening the spool assembly

 If the cutting line disappears inside the spool or needs replacing, unplug the trimmer and turn over.

- 2. Then hold the spool cover (6.2) and turn to the unlock position indicated.
- 3. Lift off the cover (6.2) to access the spool reel.
 - Take care when removing the cover that the line does not uncoil and the spring does not lift out.
- Pass the end of the line through the aperatures (6.3) on either side of the spool and postion the reel over the spring.



8. Maintenance and Troubleshooting

Important: ALWAYS switch off and unplug from the power supply before carrying out any cleaning, servicing or maintenance.

8.1 General Maintenance

- Regular inspect and clean the trimmer and spool assembly to keep the machine in good working condition.
- Remove grass from the trimmer blade and guard regularly to maintain a satisfactory cut and avoid clogging.
- Check the cutting line and extend the line using the Tap' N' Go button if performance noticeable

- deteriorates.
- · Clean the product exterior with a damp cloth ONLY.
- Important: DO NOT use solvents as this may damage the plastic parts..
- Use ONLY spare parts supplied and recommended by Draper Tools.
- Store the product in a dry and dust-free environment, out of reach of children.

9. Spares, Returns and Disposal

For spare parts, servicing, and repair and replacement options, please contact the Draper Tools Product Helpline for details of your nearest authorised agent.

Draper Tools will endeavour to hold any spare parts, if applicable, for seven years from the date that it sells the final matching stock item.
