




Indoor Lighting | Plaster-In Downlight


Mini Plaster-In Downlight

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Please read these instructions carefully before installation or operation.
- Retain this manual for future reference.
- · Please refer to product listing for detailed information.
- · Luminaire housing suitable for Class I, II or III installation depending on final configuration and associated control gear.
- · This product is a fire-rated downlight housing supplied without any light source or control gear.
- · It is designed to accept compatible retrofit lamp types and suitable control gear as determined by the installer.
- The electrical classification (Class I, II, or III) will depend on the final configuration once the light source and driver are installed.
- · This product must be installed by a suitably competent person.
- · This product should be installed in accordance with local IEE wiring regulations and building regulations.
- Remove product from packaging.
- · Fully uncoil all cables.
- Ensure mains supply is disconnected before installation.
- · Ensure others cannot restore the electrical power supply without your knowledge.
- Do not open, modify, or repair the unit. No user-serviceable parts inside.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- This product must be installed by a suitably competent person.
- · Ensure mains supply is disconnected before installation.
- Ensure others cannot restore the electrical power supply without your knowledge.
- Do not install or use the product if it is damaged.
- · For indoor use only.
- Allow adequate ventilation around the luminaire.

OPERATION

• Do not operate outside the specified ambient temperature range.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- · Ensure mains supply is disconnected before installation.
- · Ensure others cannot restore the electrical power supply without your knowledge.
- Prepare the ceiling cut-out.
- · Compress spring clips and insert the downlight into the cut-out until flush with the ceiling surface.
- Ensure the selected lamp and driver combination are compatible and comply with the relevant standards for the final installation.
- Ensure that the final installation method, wiring arrangement, and control gear selection correspond to the declared electrical safety class.
- Restore power and test the installation.

MAINTENANCE

- Before cleaning or maintenance, ensure the luminaire is disconnected from the mains.
- · Clean only with a dry, soft cloth.
- · Do not use chemical cleaners or solvents.
- · Do not open, modify, or repair the unit. No user-serviceable parts inside.

DISPOSAL & RECYCLING

- This product must not be disposed of with household waste.
- · Please return to an authorised recycling facility in accordance with local environmental regulations.

FIRE COMPLIANCE

This product has been independently tested by SGS and is compliant with BS 476-20:1987 + AC:2014 and BS 476-21:1987 + AC:2014 standards. The luminaire achieved the following fire resistance ratings:

Solid Timber: 30 / 60 / 90 minutes

Metal Web Joist: 30 minutes

Joist: 30 minutes

All fire resistance testing was assessed against Loadbearing Capacity, Integrity, and Insulation. Certificates are available upon request.
