

RHED Model Management - 16-17's Safety Policy

1. Working with 16-17 year old Models and Chaperones

RHED works in accordance with current legislation regarding the employment of persons under compulsory school age. This includes the provision of chaperones and reduced working hours.

RHED requires the written consent of a parent or guardian in order to represent a model below school leaving age. We recognise that education is a priority and will not permit it to be disrupted by the development of a career in modelling. No models under the age of 16 are employed to promote age-inappropriate clothing for brands (including, but not limited to catwalks, advertising, lookbooks, and e-commerce).

2. Chaperones

All models aged 16-17 will be accompanied by a chaperone on bookings.

Models aged 16-17 will be accompanied by a chaperone for all fashion shows and when it is a requirement of the client or parent. Where applicable this cost will be borne by the client. The chaperone is responsible for safeguarding the model and for ensuring that suitable rest and refreshment periods are complied with, and that the model is treated with respect at all times, including the provision of appropriate changing facilities.

3. Chaperone Fees & Expenses

Chaperone rates are 30% of the models rate for the time required, exclusive of the models rate and the agency fee. If required, Chaperones travel expenses and/or accommodation will be payable by the client.
