

Oxford Girls' Choir: *accompanist*

Oxford Girls' Choir is seeking an accompanist to play for weekly rehearsals, concerts and workshops, and to assist with musical direction as required. The successful candidate will be a confident sight reader with a broad range of keyboard skills.

The choir rehearses from 10:30-13:00 on Saturdays during school term at the Cherwell School in Summertown (OX2 7EE). The accompanist is paid £25-30/hour, depending on experience, with additional fees for public performances.

DBS clearance is required for this position, as is compliance with the OYC Child Protection Policy and Code of Practice. Previous OGC accompanists include Benedict Lewis-Smith, Richard Moore, Joseph Mason, Marion Bettsworth, Amy Chang and David Palmer.

Oxford Girls' Choir is the oldest classical girls' choir in the UK (founded by Richard Vendome in 1984), singing a wide repertoire from early music to jazz, sacred music, opera and new commissions. Our senior girls often proceed to university choral scholarships or conservatoire places.
