We will continue to follow government guidance as before. Our main update will be the use of face covering when we are not inside our own hubs, e.g. travelling to collect children / snack, taking children outside etc...

### Extra equipment

With the closure of 2 of our out of school clubs during the Autumn term. I have spent the last couple of weeks going through what we can use and add this to each hub. They will have a large crate of extra equipment and resources. I have added a few new items for the children too.

### Hub staff changes

Just a quick update for year 3 and 4 hubs.

Fabio will go to year 3 after school club hub.  
Sylvia will be with year 4 breakfast club hub.

### Drop off time reminders

**For breakfast club:** our drop off time is **7:30, 7:45** and the last time is **8am**, thank you.

Please do not press the buzzer. We will come to you at the above times. Thank you.

### Easter Holiday

We will be running an Easter holiday for St. Mary's pupils only. This is in line with government guidelines. There will be no off-site trips this holiday. We will email parents when we are taking bookings.

### Reception 2021 intake

With lessons learned from September 2020, we wish to avoid as many uncertainties for families as possible, so we will only be able to offer 6 reception class places for breakfast and after school club. This is on a first come first served bases. If you need a registration form for your child, please email us.

### Reception to Year 1

As stated above, the current reception children on the waiting list will be offered a place, for September 2021, increasing the number from 8 to 11-13 children. We will contact you before the Easter holidays to confirm places. Please note that these email's will be to parents who we were unable to offer places to due to us reaching the maximum number of 8.

### Collection time reminders

We have one early collection time, which is at **4pm**. Please text us on 07787 734 432 if you are collecting early so your child is ready.

There are no collections between 4 and 5pm

The next collection time is **5pm**, then **10 minutes thereafter**. We will come to the gate, no need to call us, thank you.

Please do not press the buzzer. We will come to you on the above times. Thank you.

**Please note:** We will start cleaning hub equipment from 5:30pm. If possible, please collect by this time. If not, we do understand that you still need to work and travel.

## Continuing to keep the risk of infection low

See below our key points to help reduce the risk of transmittions between you, us and the children.

1. **New:** Team to wear face covering when they are outside their bubbles / hubs.
2. Hand washing before they go into hubs and washing hands when leaving school.
3. Children will remain with their own year group hubs, as they do during the school day.
4. Breakfast and snack will be provided inside the hall on disposable bowls / plates.
5. Where possible, one team member is allocated per hub, with an overseer for some hubs.
6. The team will start clean equipment from 5:30 everyday.
7. Hubs will have set equipment and the team will not share resources where possible.
8. The outside spaces will be used as best a possible (It is important for parents to notify us by text if they are collecting at 4pm)
9. We have reduced the size of the club to 60 children so we can socially distance hubs.
