**Next week** we enter into Advent which is on the one hand a time of preparation for Christmas when we remember the first coming of Christ & at the same time, certainly in the first three weeks we think about the second coming of Christ at the end of time. Each Sunday in Advent has a distinctive theme. The 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday focuses on the Lord's coming at the end of time, the second & third Sundays on John the Baptist. The fourth Sunday looks at the events that prepared immediately for the Lord's birth.

**Today's Gospel:** Mathew 25: 31-46

*"I tell you solemnly, in so far as you did this for one of the least sisters and brothers of mine, you did to me."*

**Reflection:**

With the gospel-inspired eyes we focus our gaze on the King in whose dominion we are subjects. Today's gospel tells us what priorities the King's servants are to have & how we are to live -- feeding the hungry, giving water to the thirsty, welcoming strangers, clothing the naked, caring for the sick & visiting prisoners.

Do you look for God in all people?

Do you treat people who look differently than you as you would Christ?

What can you do to live out your faith through service?
