Despite the fact that Jesus' appearances were humble, this didn't turn people off or drive them away from him. We tend to be impressed by displays of power that fill us with awe. Jesus doesn't draw attention by such extravagant events, but because his words & actions hold out hope to the weary & hopeless. Today we join the crowds who greet Jesus as he enters Jerusalem. & add our own "Hosannas" to theirs.

So, we ask ourselves:

What is there about Jesus that draws me to him & keeps me as his follower?
What can I do to reflect his simplicity & humility in my daily actions?
