## Re-opening of School – Update

Dear Parents / Carers,

We are now in a position to update you further on the procedures in place for the re-opening of school on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**. The Government has announced that the next phase of school re-opening may be able to commence from **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020** providing that key tests are met. It is important to understand that the Government will make their final decision as to whether schools will re-open once it has reviewed the latest science on **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2020**. If evidence does not support the decision to progress school re-opening at this time, then wider school re-opening will be delayed. Waterton Academy Trustees have met and will reserve a final decision in regards to the wider re-opening of schools until **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2020** pending Government update. There is no guarantee that school will remain open from **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**; this decision will be based on ongoing review of risk assessments in place and Government guidance.

School will remain closed to all pupils for staff training and final risk assessment review on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**.

We would like to thank you for your continued support and patience at this time. Our Year 2 pupils are very much in our thoughts and we are hopeful (as are the Government) that all primary school children will be able to be welcomed back into school prior to the end of this academic year. As we receive further Government update and guidance we will share this with our Year 2 families.

We have received enquiries from several Year 2 families in regards to the transition process of pupils to junior school. Whether your child is transitioning to Altofts Junior School or an alternate provision, please be assured that the transition process between Lee Brigg Infant & Nursery School and nominated junior schools will continue. We are working with identified junior schools to ensure that transitions will go ahead in some form. As we receive further update and guidance from junior schools we will share this with our Year 2 families.

In order to support our Year 2 pupils who would like to continue learning from home, we will be supplying a further home learning pack week commencing 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020. We will provide further details in regards to the logistics of collecting these when staff return to school following the half term break. Please be assured, the collection of learning packs is optional and not compulsory. The happiness and well-being of our pupils should remain priority at this time.

Should you have any queries or concerns in regards to the above, we would ask that you contact school by telephone from **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**. School will be closed for half term **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2020** to **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020**.
