**Dates for you diary:** Our Easter 'Stay and Play' session is on **Tuesday (2<sup>nd</sup> April)**. At this session the children will decorate the Easter hat that they have made in nursery. We will provide decorations, glue, scissors etc, however, you are very welcome to bring along your own Easter decorations. **The pound shop has loads!** The session will begin at **10.30am** for the children who attend nursery in the morning and **2.30pm** for the children who attend nursery in the afternoon and it will last for approximately 45minutes. Children should come to nursery at the normal time. We kindly ask that toddlers do not attend the session. If you are unable to attend for any reason grandparents, a family friend or relative can take your place.

The children will wear the Easter hat that they make at our Easter bonnet parade on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April at 11am**, for the children who attend Nursery in the Morning and **2.45pm** for the children who attend nursery in the afternoon.

We will be holding an Easter raffle to raise funds for our outdoor area and tickets will go on sale on **Monday 1st April**. The raffle will be drawn on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April** after our Easter parade.
