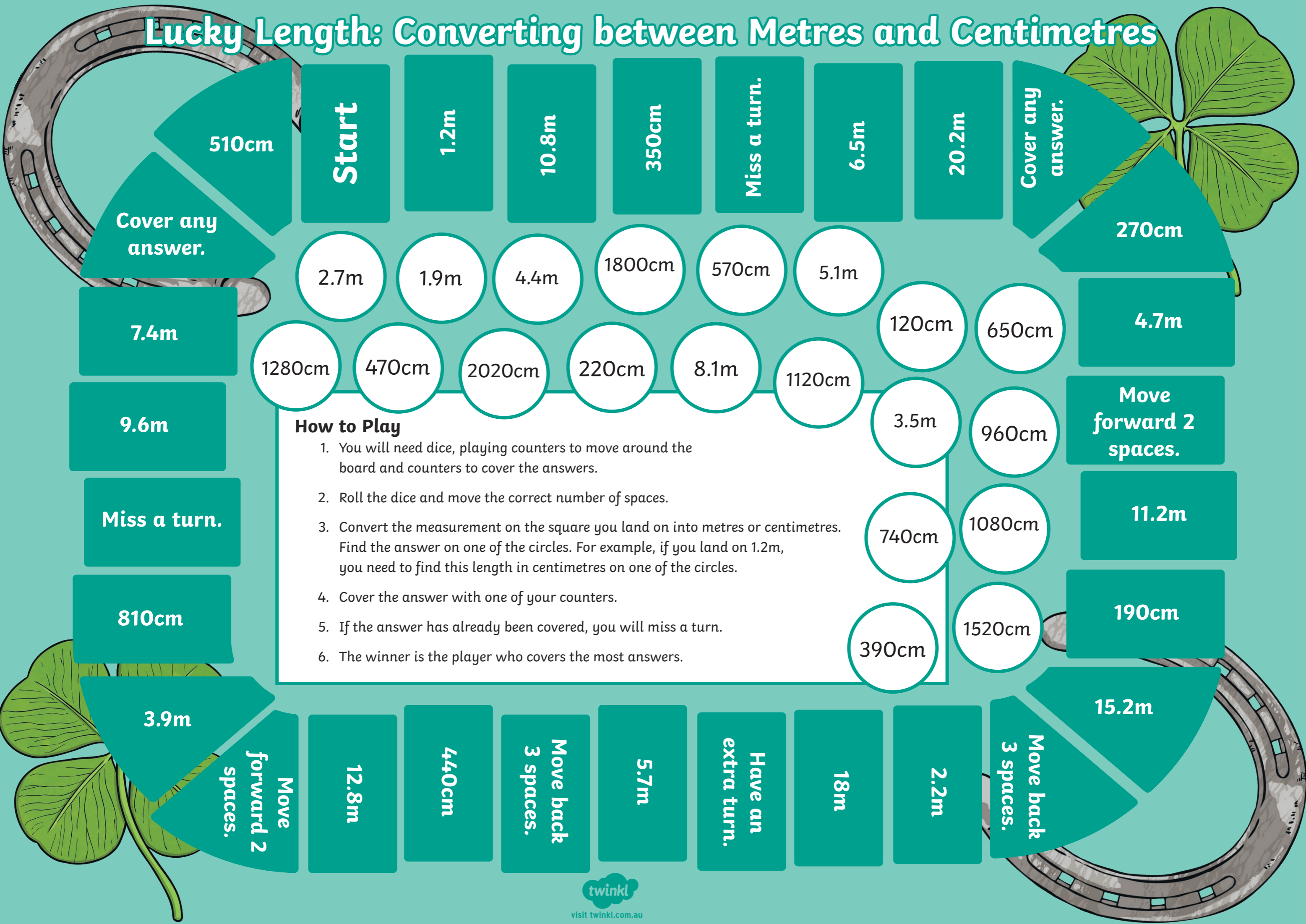


Lucky Length: Converting between Metres and Centimetres



How to Play

1. You will need dice, playing counters to move around the board and counters to cover the answers.
2. Roll the dice and move the correct number of spaces.
3. Convert the measurement on the square you land on into metres or centimetres. Find the answer on one of the circles. For example, if you land on 1.2m, you need to find this length in centimetres on one of the circles.
4. Cover the answer with one of your counters.
5. If the answer has already been covered, you will miss a turn.
6. The winner is the player who covers the most answers.
