- Nursery and Reception – Thursday 9th July between 10am and 2pm (or sent home with the child if they are in school)
- Year 1 – Thursday 9th July between 10am and 2pm (or sent home with the child if they are in school)
- Year 2 – Friday 10th July between 10am and 11am / Friday 10th July between 1pm and 2pm (or sent home with the child if they are in school)

We will make available our final paper home learning pack for this academic year for those who wish to take one when they collect their report (Reception-Year 2 pupils).

We will be uploading further online learning next week for those who wish to access (please note this will be our final online learning upload for this academic year); however, our website content as well as Oak National Academy and BBC Bitesize will remain available.

As always, any home learning is optional and not compulsory. Please remember to adhere to social distancing guidance when on site (we are only permitted one person in the reception area at any time).

School Reading Books and P.E. Kits

If your child is attending school and you have not yet returned their school reading book, please do so as soon as possible. If your child is **not** attending school, please return their school reading book when you come to collect their school report.

If your child is not attending school and has a P.E kit in class, we would ask that this be collected along with their report. Please advise when collecting reports and we will arrange to have P.E kits available.

Transition and New Classes

Ordinarily, we would be involved in a range of transition activities at this point in the academic year; however, we have had to place much of our transition programme on hold this year due to social distancing measures. We will be sending home a welcome letter from your child's new class teacher with their school report.

Each company offers the option to purchase both the item of clothing and embroidery or to have your own item of uniform embroidered. Further information is available at the school office or by clicking the links above.

We do encourage sensible black footwear to be worn in school and black pumps must be worn for P.E.

All items of clothing including the child's black pumps must be marked with the child's name. It is advisable to use either a permanent marker pen or sewn in nametapes for this purpose. Nametapes can be purchased from [My Nametags](#). Please quote our school ID which is **28025**.

We ask that children do not wear jewellery in school. The only exception to this is stud earrings and watches, which may be worn, however the school does not accept responsibility for their safety should they become lost.

For P.E. stud earrings and watches must be removed by the child, and long hair (for both girls and boys) must be tied back.

Winter

In Class:

- Navy skirt; navy pinafore dress; navy trousers (long or short); navy culottes.
- White blouse or white/red polo shirt.
- Red cardigan; red jumper; red sweater top.
- White, navy, or red tights can be worn

Indoor PE:

- White t-shirt and navy shorts.

Outdoor PE:

- White t-shirt, navy jogging bottoms and navy sweatshirt, black pumps.

Summer

In Class:

- Red short-sleeved gingham dress in any pattern of checks
- Navy shorts
- White blouse or white/red polo shirt.
- White, navy, red or black socks can be worn.

Indoor PE:

- White t-shirt and navy shorts.

Outdoor PE:

- White t-shirt and navy shorts, black pumps.
