Once at 'The Brigg' the children will swap the book, they have brought from home. We appreciate that not everyone can have time off work at such short notice, therefore, grandparents, family members and friends are welcome to come in your place. You may want to ask another parent to take your child along with his or her child and that is fine by us.
