



Our sound of the week will be 't'. Please support your child to bring an object in to nursery for our sound table such as tiger, tomato or table.

To avoid any objects being lost, can we please ask that you name the object you send in to nursery.

Our numbers of the week will be 5 and 9. Down and across and a flag on high that's the way we make a 5 and make a loop and then a line, that's the way we make a 9, are the rhymes we use to help us to recognise these numbers. You can help your child at home by pointing out numbers in the environment, reciting number names and counting different quantities in a variety of arrangements.

Next week's learning: In preparation for our chicks hatching, we will learn about the life cycle of a hen. We will watch a video of a chick hatching from an egg, follow instructions on how to paint a picture of a chick and add chicks and eggs to the maths area. We will learn a new song about chicks, listen to stories relating to chicks and learn which other creatures come from an egg.

Dates for you diary: Easter 'Stay and Play' session on **Tuesday 2nd April**. At this session the children will decorate the Easter hat that they have made in nursery. We will provide decorations, glue, scissors etc. however, you are very welcome to bring along your own Easter decorations. **The pound shop has loads!** The session will begin at **10.30am** for the children who attend nursery in the morning and **2.30pm** for the children who attend nursery in the afternoon and it will last for approximately 45minutes. Children should come to nursery at the normal time. We kindly ask that toddlers do not attend the session. If you are unable to attend for any reason grandparents, a family friend or relative can take your place. We have attached an Easter bonnet template to this newsletter so that you and your child can draw the design they would like. Please bring to the stay and play session on Tuesday so that you can follow your design!

The children will wear the Easter hat that they make at our Easter bonnet parade on **Thursday 4th April at 11am**, for the children who attend Nursery in the Morning and **2.45pm** for the children who attend nursery in the afternoon.
