School Milk

FP School Milk UK Ltd is the provider of School Milk at our school.

The process of ordering and paying for your child's milk is quick and easy and you can pay for each term (3 times a year) or for the full academic year to September.

If you would like your child to enjoy milk at school, you can register on-line at www.schoolmilkuk.co.uk. Once you have registered, there is no need to register again.

Please note that you should only register if you pay for your child's milk, if you are in receipt of benefits which qualify your child for free school meals, please speak to the school office as milk may be free.

If you choose to opt into this scheme, your child will receive a 189ml carton of fresh chilled semi-skimmed milk each school day, to drink mid-morning. The cost of this milk is 21p per day x the amount of school days in each of our school terms, payable in advance for the following full term or you can pay for a full academic year. The leaflet accompanying this note 'How to order and pay for your child's school milk' explains in detail how to register and order milk, but it is a simple process, simply log on to the website, www.schoolmilkuk.co.uk and select the pink tab titled Parent, click on register and then it is simply a case of filling in the relevant boxes with your details.

Children will only receive free school milk until the term in which they turn 5. If you need any help please speak to the school office.
