



After the holidays, our sound of the week will be 'g'. Please support your child to bring an object into nursery for our sound table such as goat, glove or gate.

To avoid any objects being lost, can we please remind you to name the object you send into nursery.

We will continue to learn about shape. You can help your child at home by talking about the shapes of everyday objects and mathematical terms to describe shapes, such as straight sides, curved side, corners.

After the holidays: Our topic will be 'Animal Adventures'. We will learn about creatures, great and small. Our first big question will be 'Which baby animals would you find on a farm?' This will help the children to learn the names of young farm animals.

On Tuesday 4th June, a travelling farm will visit school for the day. Ducks, goats, alpacas, hens, lambs are just some of the animals that will visit. The children will get the opportunity to feed the animals and touch them.

We will read a variety of stories such as The Three Little Pigs, The Three Billy Goats Gruff, Bumble Bear and The Dance of the Dinosaurs.

It is 'Dough Disco' day on June 14th. We would like to invite you to come and join in with some of our dough disco routines. If your child attends nursery in the morning, please return at 10.45am. If your child attends nursery in the afternoon please return at 2.45pm.

Dough Disco exercises the fingers to improve fine motor control. We develop our fine motor skills through pinching, rolling and squeezing. If you would like to have a go at dough disco over the holidays, there is a recipe for homemade playdough overleaf. Some of the moves we do are ball it (roll it into a ball), roll it into a sausage, squeeze it, prod it, pinch it. We are sure you will have fun!

Play dough recipe

2 cups of plain flour

4 tablespoons of oil

1 cup of salt

4 teaspoons of cream of tartar

2 cups of boiling water (adding in small increments until the dough forms)

Food colouring

Few drops of glycerine can be added to add stretch and shine
