The clothing can be any colour; it does not have to be a school PE kit. Please name the clothing and make sure you put it in a named bag.

Next week's learning: Tiger Cub will begin his adventures at the children's homes. Each day, someone will bring Tiger Cub home and we ask that you support your child to care for her. She will come home in a bag, along with pencils, paper and some of Tiger Cubs belongings. Please return Tiger Cub to Nursery the next day. This needs to happen to ensure that every child gets a turn. This activity helps the children with their Personal, Social and Emotional and communication and language development. We look forward to reading everyone's story.

We will be responding to the children's interests and having a Toy Story week. The children will take part in a variety of activities that will enable them to write, join materials, cut and use talk, new vocabulary and have conversations.
