



After the holidays, our sound of the week will be 'n'. Please support your child in bringing an item that has the initial sound 'n' such as necklace, nose, net or noodles on Monday 5th November.

We are going to continue to learn numbers 4 and 9. We hope the number rhyme sheet was useful. You can help your child at home by saying the rhymes with your child as you point out numbers in the environment.

This week's learning: We have had a Halloween frenzy! Pumpkins, witches, wizards, a skeleton dance, magic spells, tricks, stories and songs. The children enjoyed jelly day! It was a reward chosen by the children for filling the golden pebble jar.

After the holidays, our topic will be 'Let's Celebrate'. We will celebrate Bonfire Night, Diwali, Polly's (the Nursery puppet) birthday and Christmas. Various activities will take place to develop the children's skills in speaking, making relationships, writing, number and being imaginative.
