## School Opening Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the Government announcement on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020, the authorities believe that they *could* be in a position to begin a phased approach to reopening schools from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020, primarily for children currently in Nursery, Reception and Year 1 cohorts.

At Lee Brigg Infant & Nursery School, we are finalising our procedures and safety measures in preparation for a *possible* reopening of school on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020. The decision to reopen depends upon criteria within the Government's conditional plan which will remain under regular review.

In order to assist in the planning process Waterton Academy Trust have created an online form for parents and carers to complete. The purpose of this form will be for you to advise whether or not you would intend to send your child(ren) back to school on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020. We ask that you please complete this form no later than Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May (the deadline for submission is 12 noon). The link to the form can be found below:

It is important that we are able to anticipate the number of pupils who would intend to return to school on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020, in order to make preparations and ensure adherence to government protocol. Please Note: There may be an adjustment to 'normal' school hours, which will be explained at a later date. Procedures and processes will be reviewed in their entirety on a rolling three weekly basis from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.

Please be reassured that the safety and well-being of your child(ren) are our foremost priority and we will adhere to government and Trust guidance to ensure that we are operating as safely as possible. Further information will be sent out next week outlining the procedures that will need to be adhered to by parents and carers to support school with this.
