Dear Parents and Carers,

We are continuing with the teaching of key values for those children in eligible groups who have returned to school. This remains an area of education that staff feel strongly will equip our children well for their learning in the future.

As well as the existing school ethos, which promotes our '[Golden Rules](#),' praising children when they behave and treat others positively; we will continue to 'teach' a core **value** each half term, which will be a focus for discussions.

This half term we shall be focussing on the values of '**Keeping Active, Being Healthy.**'

Staff in school are on the 'lookout' for children demonstrating these values. They have already discussed what keeping active and being healthy means, therefore, children who have returned to school are aware and already understand what we are looking for. **Examples could be making good choices about eating a balanced diet, eating a range of different foods, going on a bike ride, trying new healthy foods, taking daily exercise, brushing teeth, personal hygiene, drinking water or going to bed on time!**

We would very much like to also share the teaching of these values with our pupils who currently remain at home, and as such (for those who would like to participate and may need resource to support) we attach below a link to a short video which explains 'what humans need to keep healthy' (*source: BBC Education*). **We would ask that Parents and Carers review content of this resource for suitability prior to sharing with children as we appreciate that there may exist anxieties around subjects mentioned in the clip.**
