Dear Parent/ Carer,

New guidance has been released and plans are being put together for everybody to return to school on Wednesday 9th September. The last time most of you were in school was Friday 20th March!

Things will still look a little different from how they were, we will continue to minimise the number of contacts between children and adults, as well as avoiding large gatherings. In order to do this, children will be remaining within their class as a “bubble” with certain adults designated to work within this bubble. Children will have staggered starts to the day, staggered breaks, lunches and finishes to the school day. They will be keeping their belongings with them in the classroom so these need to be kept to a minimum . On PE days they will come in their kits so that they do not need to bring large bags into the classrooms, which are restricted for space. There will be outdoor PE only and assemblies will also be within their classrooms. Handwashing and good hygiene will be a high priority throughout the day, with additional cleaning being completed within the school in the middle of the day.

The full risk assessment will be made available to you all on our website nearer the time. A child friendly version will also be coming out to you so that you can prepare your children.

So that you and your family can make plans for work and dropping of other siblings in September, the timings for your child’s school day are below. If you have siblings with different drop off times and are unable to drop off separately, please adhere to the earlier time for dropping off and the later one for pick up. Your child will be directed to the school hall where they will wait with a member of staff. You will have to drop your children off at the school gates, staff will be there to guide your children to the correct entrance with particular consideration for our new pupils in Year 3.

Breakfast club will be operating as normal and opens at 8am if you wish to book in.

You will receive further information from myself before we start back. Please be assured that all the planning is to ensure the children and staffs continued safety.
