Absences

If your child is unable to attend due to sickness/holiday, could you please let us know by calling or texting the Playways mobile. If we do not receive any call or text we will, in the interest of safeguarding contact you to ensure everything is ok.

Collection of children

Please remember to collect your child promptly at the end of each session. It can be very unsettling for a child to be left in the setting when all the other children have been collected. This is particularly important to minimise disruption at 12pm when we have children leaving and arriving.

We open the door 5 minutes prior to the end time.

Outside Play

We are very lucky at Playways to have such a large outside area for the children to play in and we do use it all the year round, therefore please ensure your children are dressed according to the weather.

Please also ensure their coats/hats/wellies etc. have their names written in them as trying to locate every child's outerwear when we want to go out to play is extremely time consuming.

If it is wet outside, please send your child in with wellington/waterproof boots for splashing in puddles and playing in mud. In our garden, we do have our mud kitchen, so don't be alarmed if your children come home quite mucky! Please do not send them to school in decent clothes that you do not want to get dirty or stained.

On that note, we have uniform order forms at the entrance to the setting and sending your child into school in Playways uniform will ensure their best clothes, stay best!!

ParentMail

ParentMail is a service used by over 6000 schools, nurseries and children's clubs to communicate with parents.

Improving School Communications with ParentMail

Communicating with parents is an important part of what we do, making sure you get the correct information about school news, activities and things that really matter is something we care about.

From 1st December 2018 we will be using ParentMail, a service used by over 6,000 schools, nurseries and children's clubs to communicate to parents. ParentMail will be beneficial to you because you can:

- Use a free mobile app on Android and iOS to pick up school messages instantly.
- Have an account simply for school messages (away from your busy email inbox!)
- Connect to other schools, nurseries or clubs that use ParentMail.
- Highlight important messages or archive old messages to make life easier.
- Messages can be sent directly to mums, dads and carers – even grandparents!

Registering with ParentMail is very easy! Over the next few days you will be sent an email from ParentMail, when you receive this please just follow the instructions in the message.

Please be assured that ParentMail is registered with the Information Commissioner and guarantees that all information you provide will be kept private and will not be passed on to any other organisation.

Once registered, if you have an Android or Apple smartphone, we would highly recommend you download the ParentMail App for the best user experience. To do this, simply search for "ParentMail" in your App store.
