

**Course Title:** Paediatric First aid Level 3

**Duration:** 2 Days

**Broad Aims:** to give the learner the knowledge, skills and confidence to respond effectively, safely and promptly to an emergency situation that may involve babies, toddlers and children within the workplace.

**Overview**

This course has been designed and developed for people working with babies, toddlers and children who have a duty to provide first aid cover until professional help arrives.

It has been designed to give the learner the knowledge and practical skills to recognise and treat a number of injuries, conditions and illnesses that are common to babies, toddlers and children from birth to puberty.

The learner will be assessed through ongoing practical observations and a multi choice written exam at the end of the session. Each learner if applicable, will receive an AoFAQ Level 3 certificate in Paediatric First aid.

**Learning Outcomes:** By the end of the day, learners should be able to:

- Describe the role of the paediatric first aider
- Explain what to do with emergencies
- Demonstrate what to do with an unconscious casualty
- Discuss, practice and perform Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Cite the recognition features and treatment of a choking casualty
- Recognise and treat a child in shock
- Demonstrate what to do with bleeding wounds
- Describe common chronic medical conditions and sudden illness
- Discuss the effects of extreme heat and cold
- Demonstrate the appropriate treatment of a suspected fracture and dislocation
- Discuss what to do with head, neck and back injuries
- Describe and discuss conditions affecting the eyes, ears and nose
