Your supports as parents/carers in directing our young people to wear their coverings on school transport, communal areas, toilets and corridors is greatly appreciated. Please see an update on a variety of matters below:

Outside areas

We have moved the outside areas of some year groups to allow easier access to their indoor spaces in inclement weather. These are now as follows:

Morning interval and lunchtimes (when dry outside)

S1 – back of school
S2 – side of school
S3 – front of school

Before school (when dry outside)

S1/2 – back of school
S3/4 – side of school
S5/6 – front of school

Inclement weather arrangements remain as follows:

S1 – Hub
S2/3 – Games Hall

S4 – Hub
S5/6 – Games Hall

No doubt such arrangement will continue to evolve as we move through the session, listening to the views of our young people.
