Requesting an SQA Post-Certification Appeal

As a result of Covid-19 and the revised certification procedures for 2020, SQA have re-introduced evidence-based appeals for this session. This involves pupils requesting an SQA Post-Certification Appeal if they feel that their grade is below that which was expected.

Pupils wishing to request an Appeal should not come into the school building, should phone the school office (01324 719551) or contact Mr Ironside (david.ironside@falkirk.gov.uk).

Please highlight if this is a priority appeal for entry into college/university.

This will then be taken to the relevant Faculty Head and we will communicate with you by Friday 14th August to confirm that this is/is not being taken forward. If we cannot take this forward, we will explain why at this point.

Please note that we can only submit an appeal where the awarded grade is lower than the school's estimated grade.
